Dear Miss O'Brien:

Although some time has elapsed since our brief conference in New York City, I have been active in establishing the proposed chapters of the I.R.E. in Turkey. The enclosed letter to Professors Mustafa Santur and Adaman Adaman will give you some idea. Will need some help from headquarters, however.

I was pleasantly surprised to find the promised material waiting for me when I arrived home (in Ankara) after a survey of the Istanbul and Izmir areas. As you will note in the copy of the letter enclosed, I sent one-half on to Istanbul (and retained the other for use in Ankara). It would be most helpful if you could send a copy of the Section I (book on I.R.E. in a blue folder) to Professors Santur and Ataman at: I. Teknik Universitesi, Elektrik Fakultesi, Boyoglu, Istanbul, Turkey; and also enclose at least 25 copies for student membership. Although they were told that there should be at least 25 associated or higher grade applicants or members to start a chapter, they felt confident that it could be done. I believe they could easily 25nd 25 student members in addition. The "Blue Book" would be helpful to them and answer a lot of questions without reference to me (by mail or telephone). Professor Santur enjoys the same type of reputation (professional) that Professor Terman (of Stanford U.) does in the U.S. What I am trying to say is that he is of "high calibre" and am most pleased to have his interest and cooperation in establishing the Istanbul chapter. For this reason alone, I feel that it will be successful and will live on long after I have returned to the states.

Another copy of the "Blue Book" for the forthcoming Ankara chapter should he mailed to: Mithat Esmer, P. K. No. 700, Ankara, Turkey. He is a member of the IRE (Assoc., that is) and will be very helpful in organization. Also the Managering-Engineer of Ankara Short Wave Broadcasting system. As I have the only "Blue Book" (Section I) available, the two others would serve as an immediate reference to the proposed chapter officers. Although expensive, it would be advisable to mail them by Air Mail Parcel Post or Air Express. Things are moving that fast!

Enclosed, find a check for \$15.00 and the Transfer Application to the MK grade of Senior Member, ----as well as a ballot (if it arrives before Oct. 24th). Although normally it takes some time for investigation, I would appreciate it if this could be passed on immediately by the Board for the sake of local prestige during the organizational period. If, for any reason, my claims are not supported by the references given, ---will back down" immediately to that of an ordinary member. Incidently, I could not give the names of fellow Sr. Members as they would not know of the claims made directly, and therefore could not support the statements. I trust the others, that are engaged in my speciality (education in the field of Electronics) will be acceptable substitutes.

Incidently, an informal report to the Board is enclosed describing the conditions, working difficulties and handicaps to be overcome in Turkey. I know you will take care of it as soon as possible.

Thanks for your past assistance, and I hope I'll hear from you and the others of IRE soon. Also thanks to your Editor for the photographs. Will send newspaper and magazine clippings as soon as they have been properly used.

Gentlemen:

In regard to the proposed chapter of the Institute of Radio Engineers for Istanbul, I am sending some descriptive material and application forms under separate mailing.

In addition, the New York Headquarters of the I.R.E. is being asked to send directly to you, their special book (Section I) on the BytLaws, Amendments and suggestions to be used in forming a chapter. Also being requested, is applications for student members of the I.R.E., at least 25 copies. You should receive these within a relatively short time. In the meanwhile, it would be most helpful if you could take their names, of those interested in joining the I.R.E. as student members.

From my survey of Istanbul and Izmir, in the radio and electronic field, I am thoroughly convinced that it would be of tremendous advantage to the people of Turkey and their government to establish a chapter of the I.R.E. at Istanbul and Ankara. Accordingly, I am working with some local radio engineering groups in Ankara towards this end, but must depend upon you to do the "ground-work" in Istanbul. I will return to Istabbul whenever you feel the opportune time has come to hold the first meeing, --- and will make a special trip for this purpose and stay as long as you wish or feel that I may be of further assistance. Please do not hesitate to call on me when enough potential members have been contacted or signed up. The membership fee quoted in American Dollars will offer a problem in view of the tight restrictions, but I feel sure that with your assistance, this detail can be taken care of. If you do not find a ready solution, I might be able to call on a banker friend in the U. S. for assistance. This is mentioned only as an answer to this possible source of objection or "sales resistance" when you contact potential members.

In addition, I am enclosing a list of prospective members that I met in Istanbul, that might be interested in joining forces and of whom I might say would become valuable members. If convenient, please contact them in addition to those you know or believe would be interested in the proposed Chapter.

In the meanwhile, please feel free to contact me if any obstacles loom up. Thanks again for your interest and cooperation.

The coupons may be purchased in Turkish currency and may be redeemed in the United States in our currency.

In order to asquaint you with the circumstances that exist at the moment and to better understand the obstacles to be overcome in establishing Chapters of the I.R.E., please consider the following:

Since 1950, the Turkish Government have been faced with a serious importexport unbalance. They were also faced with the prospects of a run-away type of inflation that would rival that which happened to Germany after World War I. In desperation, on July 11, 1956, they passed a law fixing prices and establishing price and trade ceilings, restrictions on imports and exports of raw materials and money.

Since this time, all outside trade is controlled by the Minister of Finance, and the export dollar carefully guarded and rationed out. Hardly anything can be purchased from the United States as they can not sell but very little in return. Most of the trading done at present (in radio and electronics) is with Holland, Germany, France and England. These laws are so tight and enforced to such an extent, that even Phillips Radio (of Holland) is operating on less than a two months supply of raw materials needed on the manufacturer of radios. Needless to say, no traces of research and development can be found with the exception of what little is being done in the University of Istanbul.

Perhaps most of you are aware of the above conditions and wonder just how this applies to the I.R.E. Consider first, the matter of the \$10.00 membership fee or the \$5.00 for student members.

The official rate of exchange for the Turkish Pound (called the Lira) is 2.8 for \$1.00 (American). Unfortunately, the Lira is not stable and on the "free market" at Geneva, New York City, Beirut, etc. it varies from 6 to as high as 12 to one. At this moment it is 9.2 to \$1.00.

If a Turk is caught dealing on the resulting "black market" in this country or tries to smuggle money in or out, he can be sent up for LIFE IMPRISONMENT! Their laws really have teeth in them and they are fairly well enforced. And here is the first problem, ---

At \$10.00, the official, "pegged" rate being 2.8 would be only twenty eight Lira for membership for the Turkish Engineer. Assuming the "free market" rate being 8 to \$1.00, when you cashed their check in New York, you would receive approximately \$3.50. On the other hand, if they had a "friend" on the outside that would see that you received the full \$10.00 (American), they would have to pay approximately eighty Lira (or more) for membership.

This a poor country, ---not from resources alone, but also they are very proudd. I do not know at the moment if they would pay this amount (80 T. L.) for membership, as the average engineers receives from 800 to 1,100 T. L. per month. Their experienced radio servicemen from 450 to 650 T. L. per month. Although this membership fee is a very minor detail in the U. S., it could prove to be a decided handicap and offer some "sales resistance."

Raw materials are difficult to obtain, either for manufacturing purposes or training in schools. The most critical items (for manufacturing) are: Tubes, electrolytic condensers, resistors (better than 10%) and loud speakers of the PM types. The same is true of the schools, except in addition to those parts listed, add all types of test equipment, ---VTVM's, Tube Testors, Signal Generators in particular. This information is based upon the findings at five manufacturers, three trade schools and one University contacted on a recent survey. It is mentioned as in your "Section I" of the By-Laws, Amendments, etc. of I.R.E., that all financial assistance to individual chapters must originate at the N.Y. headquarters of I.R.E. With the financial picture being as it is in Turkey, it would be more helpful to gather up old "obsolete" test equipment, used tubes, electrolytic condensers, etc., and ship them over for use by the schools and forthcoming projects sponsored by the new IRE chapters. I believe I could get the ILO/UNESCO group to finance the freight for same on this type of donation, and it would be much better than sending them money. Your opinion on this subject would be appreciated.


