Tracy,

I agree that we should for now return the counties of Burke and Caldwell and associated members to the Western North Carolina. I have added the Chairs of the Western NC Section (Robert Pettigrew), Charlotte Section (Natalie Sayles) and NC Council (Chip Dawson) to my reply to you. I will follow up with a discussion with these folks and see how they would like to resolve this issue.

My concern is that none of the Subsections (Hickory, Greenville, or Lower Cape Fear) within the North Carolina Council seem to be active and we should consider merging the membership back into the Sections. By-the-way when is the last time you folks received a report from these Subsections? We may want to try to look at setting up geographic areas within each Section similar to the Nashville Section experiment.

I am glad that you folks discovered this problem and I will keep you posted on our progress to resolve it.

BYLAWS OF THE
WESTERN NORTH CAROLINA SUBSECTION
OF THE INSTITUTE OF RADIO ENGINEERS

Effective November 20, 1959

ARTICLE I

Name

- Section 1. This organization shall be known as the Western North Carolina Subsection of the Institute of Radio Engineers.
- Section 2. Where the term "national organization" is used in these bylaws, it shall refer to the Institute of Radio Engineers with main office at One East 79th Street, New York City, New York.
- Section 3. Where the term "parent organization" is used in these bylaws, it shall refer to the North Carolina Section of the Institute of Radio Engineers.

ARTICLE II

Organization and Scope

- Section 1. The organized territory served by this Subsection shall consist of counties as follows:

Alexander	Catawba	Henderson	Mecklenburg	Stanley
Anson	Cherokee	Iredell	Mitchell	Swain
Avery	Clay	Jackson	Montgomery	Transylvania
Buncombe	Cleveland	Lincoln	Polk	Union

All the above counties are located in North Carolina.

- Section 2. A change in the Subsection boundaries may be made by appropriate methods as set forth in the national organization's Constitution and Bylaws.
- Section 3. It is the object of this Subsection to further the aims and ideals of the Institute and promote the professional welfare of its members by holding technical meetings and participating in other activities pertaining to the electronic and allied arts.

ARTICLE III

Membership

- Section 1.** Members of this subsection shall consist of six classifications. They are as follows: Fellows, Senior Members, Special Members, Members, Associates and Students.
- Section 2.** Qualifications for the various membership grades shall be the same as specified in the national organization's Constitution and Bylaws.

ARTICLE IV

Officers

- Section 1.** Officers of this Subsection shall consist of a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The standing committees shall be Membership, Publicity, and Meetings and Papers. Special committees may be appointed as required.
- Section 2.** The Executive Committee shall consist of all regular elected officers and the chairmen of the standing committees. The Junior Past Chairman of the Subsection shall be an ex-officio member of the Executive Committee.
- Section 3.** The qualifications of members who hold subsection office shall be governed by the rules set forth in the national organization pertaining to subsection officers.
- Section 4.** Term of office shall be for one year and coincide with term of section officers. Current officers shall serve through 1960.
- Section 5.** The duties of all subsection officers shall be governed by those specified by the national organization's Constitution and Bylaws.

ARTICLE V

Nomination of Officers

- Section 1.** The Subsection Chairman shall appoint a Nominating Committee composed of IRE members in good standing and who are willing to serve.
- Section 2.** The Nominating Committee shall meet in time to draw up a slate of officers to be placed in nomination for election at the second meeting prior to the expiration of the subsection year. Nominations from the floor will be accepted at this time.

Section 3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer shall constitute the elective officers.

ARTICLE VI

Elections

Section 1. Officers shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the votes cast.

Section 2. Election ballots for subsection officers shall be prepared by the Secretary and mailed to the subsection membership following the nomination meeting. All ballots must be returned no later than the final meeting of the subsection year. Counting of ballots shall be done at this meeting.

Section 3. All standing and special committees shall be appointed by the Subsection Chairman, subject to the approval of the Executive Committee.

Section 4. Terms of all standing committeemen shall coincide with that of the elected officers.

ARTICLE VII

Meetings

Section 1. There shall be a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of ten (10) meetings held each year.

Section 2. The location of the meetings shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

Section 3. The annual meeting shall be the first meeting of each Subsection year.

ARTICLE VIII

Dues

Section 1. There shall be no subsection dues required of the membership.

Section 2. Operational expenses are received from the parent organization at the rate of \$0.50 per capita of the Subsection membership, plus \$10.00 for each meeting held per year up to 10 meetings.

Section 3. No assessments shall be levied upon members of this subsection. Donations may be solicited for operational expenses, however, such donations shall be specified for a single purpose and shall have the unanimous approval of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE IX

General

- Section 1. Twenty (20) percent of this subsection membership shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at regular or called meetings.
- Section 2. A simple majority shall constitute a quorum at all Executive Committee meetings for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE X

Amendments to Bylaws

- Section 1. No bylaws shall be adopted, the provisions of which are in conflict with any bylaws or regulations of the national or parent organization.
- Section 2. Bylaws may be amended, or additions thereto may be made, by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast by the subsection membership. Changes in the bylaws shall be accomplished by referendum vote of the subsection by mail.

- Section 3. Where the term "parent organization" is used in these bylaws, it shall refer to the North Carolina-Virginia Section of the Institute of Radio Engineers.

ARTICLE II

Organization and Scope

- Section 1. The organized territory served by this Subsection shall consist of counties as follows:

Alexander	Catawba	Henderson	Mecklenburg	Stanley

Caldwell	Haywood	McDowell	Rutherford	

All the above counties are located in North Carolina.

- Section 2. A change in the Subsection boundaries may be made by appropriate methods as set forth in the national organization's Constitution and Bylaws.
- Section 3. It is the object of this Subsection to further the aims and ideals of the Institute and promote the professional welfare of its members by holding technical meetings and participating in other activities pertaining to the electronic and allied arts.

ARTICLE III

Membership

- Section 1. Members of this subsection shall consist of six classifications. They are as follows: Fellows, Senior Members, Special Members, Members, Associates and Students.
- Section 2. Qualifications for the various membership grades shall be the same as specified in the national organization's Constitution and Bylaws.

ARTICLE IV

Officers

- Section 1. Officers of this Subsection shall consist of a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, a Secretary and a Treasurer. The standing committees shall be Membership, Publicity, and Meetings and Papers. Special committees may be appointed as required.
- Section 2. The Executive Committee shall consist of all regular elected officers and the chairmen of the standing committees. The Junior Past Chairman of the Subsection shall be an ex-officio member of the Executive Committee.
- Section 3. The qualifications of members who hold subsection office shall be governed by the rules set forth in the national organization pertaining to subsection officers.
- Section 4. Term of office shall be for one year, except that officers elected in January, 1957 shall serve the entire fiscal year ending June, 1958.
- Section 5. The duties of all subsection officers shall be governed by those specified by the national organization's Constitution and Bylaws.

ARTICLE V

Nomination of Officers

- Section 1. The Subsection Chairman shall appoint a Nominating Committee composed of IRE members in good standing and who are willing to serve.
- Section 2. The Nominating Committee shall meet in time to draw up a slate of officers to be placed in nomination for election not later than April meeting of the Subsection.

Section 3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer shall constitute the elective officers.

ARTICLE VI

Elections

Section 1. Officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the membership.

Section 2. Election ballots for subsection officers shall be prepared by the Secretary and mailed to the subsection membership along with the April meeting notice. All ballots shall be returned no later than the April meeting date. All voting and counting of ballots shall be done at the April meeting of the Subsection.

Section 3. All standing and special committees shall be appointed by the Subsection Chairman, subject to the approval of the Executive Committee.

Section 4. Terms of all standing committeemen shall coincide with that of the elected officers.

ARTICLE VII

Meetings

Section 1. There shall be a minimum of three (3) and a maximum of ten (10) meetings held each year.

Section 2. The location of the meetings shall be determined by the Executive Committee.

Section 3. The annual meeting shall be held in June of each year.

ARTICLE VIII

Dues

Section 1. There shall be no subsection dues required of the membership.

Section 2. Operational expenses are received from the parent organization at the rate of \$0.50 per capita of the Subsection membership, plus \$10.00 for each meeting held per year up to 10 meetings.

Section 3. No assessments shall be levied upon members of this subsection. Donations may be solicited for operational expenses, however, such donations shall be specified for a single purpose and shall have the unanimous approval of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE IX

General

- Section 1. Twenty (20) percent of this subsection membership shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at regular or called meetings.
- Section 2. A simple majority shall constitute a quorum at all Executive Committee meetings for the transaction of business.

ARTICLE X

Amendments to Bylaws

- Section 1. No bylaws shall be adopted, the provisions of which are in conflict with any bylaws or regulations of the national or parent organization.
- Section 2. Bylaws may be amended, or additions thereto may be made, by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast by the subsection membership. Changes in the bylaws shall be accomplished by referendum vote of the subsection by mail.
