Official correspondence has been received informing us that the petition, 46 of us signed, was acted upon favorably by the I.R.E. Board of Directors on June 18th. A nominating committee has been named to prepare a list of candidates for office. The Nominating Committee consists of:

P. M. Cruse Santa Barbara Research Center, Chairman

J. T. Patchell Raytheon

W. M. Robbins, Jr. Aerophysics

Any members who wish to suggest that certain persons be nominated should make their recommendations to the Committee so it can prepare a list of nominees from which a slate of officers can be elected. Tentative plans call for a last-half-of August mail balloting so that the returns may be tallied and the permanent officers may be installed at the September meeting which is tentatively planned for September 12th. It is important that you cast your vote, not just for the candidates of your choice but also for your preference as to the day of the week and time of the month for our meetings.

Up to now, just a few members have shared the responsibility and the work. Now that the Santa Barbara Sub-section has been formally approved, if it is to be the instrument of service to I.R.E. members, which we hope it will, many willing hands and talents will be needed to support its operation. The extent to which it can serve you depends in no small

degree on how much of your time and effort you can contribute to getting it started and directed properly!

Last winter a letter was mailed to all I.R.E. members known to reside in the Santa Barbara area to determine the amount of interest which there might be in technical program activities here. A number of I.R.E. members representing Raytheon, Aerophysics, TEMPO and D & R. responded to the letter, by meeting and forming, unofficially an Ad Hoc Committee. At one of the early meetings, plans were made to conduct an unofficial census of local I.R.E. members - and to investigate possible steps we could take within the framework of the I.R.E. to promote technical programs in the area.

As a result of such preparatory steps, it was decided to circulate a petition seeking Sub-section status. Dr. Hausz served on the papers Review Committee from 1951-1953 and was Chairman of the National Convention Record Committee for 1953-54. Charles Hedges, M, I. R. E., of Aerophysics was named acting Publicity Chairman.

Two delegates from Santa Barbara took copies of our petition, with forty-six signatures to the Executive Committee meeting of the Los Angeles Section where it was accepted for transmittal to New York for their action (which was reported above).
