Official correspondence has been received informing us that the petition, 46 of us signed, was acted upon favorably by the I. R. E. Board of Directors on June 18th. A nominating committee has been named to prepare a list of candidates for office. The Nominating Committee consists of:

Any members who wish to suggest that certain persons be nominated should make their recommendations to the Committee so it can prepare a list of nominees from which a slate of officers can be elected. Tentative plans call for a last-half-of August mail balloting so that the returns may be tallied and the permanent officers may be installed at the September meeting which is tentatively planned for September 12th. It is important that you cast your vote, not just for the candidates of your choice but also for your preference as to the day of the week and time of the month for our meetings.

Up to now, just a few members have shared the responsibility and the work. Now that the Santa Barbara Sub-section has been formally approved, if it is to be the instrument of service to I. R. E. members, which we hope it will, many willing hands and talents will be needed to support its operation. The extent to which it can serve you depends in no small

degree on how much of your time and effort you can contribute to getting it started and directed properly!

Last winter a letter was mailed to all I. R. E. members known to reside in the Santa Barbara area to determine the amount of interest which there might be in technical program activities here. A number of I. R. E. members representing Raytheon, Aerophysics, TEMPO and D & R, responded to the letter, by meeting and forming, unofficially an Ad Hoc Committee. At one of the early meetings, plans were made to conduct an unofficial census of local I. R. E. members - and to investigate possible steps we could take within the framework of the I. R. E. to promote technical programs in the area.

As a result of such preparatory steps, it was decided to circulate a petition seeking Sub-section status. We had no doubt that the required number of signatures for the petition could be secured or that there was sufficient interest to present a real need for I. R. E. technical program activities. Acting officers were elected by the Ad Hoc Committee to serve until they could be replaced by regularly elected officers. George Maki, SM, I. R. E., of Santa Barbara Research was named acting Chairman. R. S. Hutcheon, AM, I. R. E. of Raytheon was named acting Secretary-Treasurer. Dr. Walter Hausz, Fellow, I. R. E., of G. E. TEMPO was named acting Program Chairman. We are especially fortunate to have so capable and distinguished a man in this capacity. Dr. Hausz served on the papers Review Committee from 1951-1953 and was Chairman of the National Convention Record Committee for 1953-54. Charles Hedges, M, I. R. E., of Aerophysics was named acting Publicity Chairman.

Two delegates from Santa Barbara took copies of our petition, with forty-six signatures to the Executive Committee meeting of the Los Angeles Section where it was accepted for transmittal to New York for their action (which was reported above).

Subject: Vandenberg Section Participation in Los Angeles Council

During the past several years, the Los Angeles Council has drastically reduced the percentage of rebate passed on to the Vandenberg Section (36% in 1973 and less in 1974). The Los Angeles Council estimated budget for 1974-75 projects a similar return in the future.

This reduced funding for the Vandenberg Section has had a detrimental effect on the Section and has greatly reduced activity. The Los Angeles Council has been advised of this situation and have stated that they are passing on to the Sections all they can in this austere period.

Since the Vandenberg Section is 175 miles from the Los Angeles area and the membership can take little advantage of the activities for which the majority of the Los Angeles Council budget is allocated, it is the consensus of the membership that the interests of the Section can best be served by withdrawing from the Los Angeles Council.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the Vandenberg Section be removed from the rolls of the Los Angeles Council and established as an independent Section. It is further requested that subsequent rebates be submitted directly to the Vandenberg Section.

During the past several years, the Los Angeles Council has drastically reduced the percentage of rebate passed on to the Vandenberg Section (36% in 1973 and less in 1974). The Los Angeles Council estimated budget for 1974-75 projects a similar return in the future.

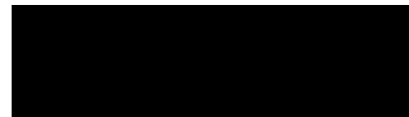

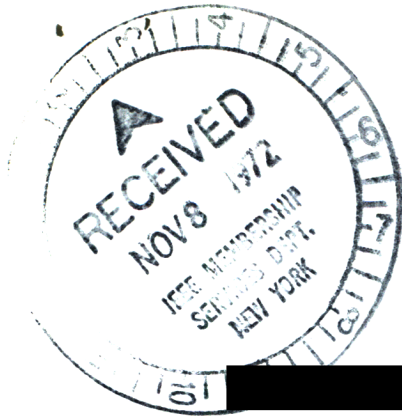


Reference the inclosed letter dated 25 October and the Preliminary Prospectus dated 17 October 1972.
