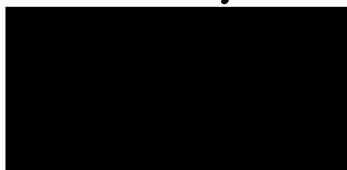

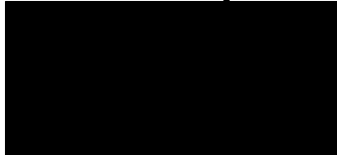

Article I - Name and Object

- Sec. 1. This organization shall be known as the Princeton Section of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers.
- Sec. 2. The Section shall strive for the advancement of the theory and practice of electrical engineering, electronics, radio, allied branches of engineering and of the related arts and sciences, and the maintenance of high professional standards among its members, all in consonance with the IEEE Constitution and Bylaws and with special attention to such aims within the territory of the Section as are hereinafter defined.
- Sec. 3. The Section shall hold meetings for the transaction of the regular business of the Section and for the presentation of papers and their discussion, and shall aid in promoting close cooperation and good fellowship among its members.

Article II - Membership

- Sec. 1. All members of the IEEE with IEEE mailing addresses within the territory of the Section are automatically members of this Section. There shall be no other grades of membership.
- Sec. 2. All Fellows, Senior Members, and Members of the IEEE with IEEE mailing addresses within the territory of the Section shall be entitled to attend the meetings, vote and hold office. Associates of the IEEE within the territory of a Section shall be entitled to attend meetings and vote, but shall not have the right to hold office.
- Sec. 3. Student members of the IEEE shall be entitled to attend meetings but shall not have the right to vote or hold office.

Article III - Professional Technical Group Affiliates

- Sec. 1. The Section shall recognize all Professional Technical Group Affiliate in good standing, having mailing addresses within the territory of the Section.
- Sec. 2. Each Affiliate so recognized shall receive notices regarding meetings, symposia, conferences, conventions and other pertinent functions and activities of the Professional Technical Group or Groups with which he is affiliated.



- Sec. 3. An Affiliate shall be entitled to attend and participate in activities of the Professional Technical Group or Groups with which he is affiliated by payment of the same charges as IEEE members.
- Sec. 4. An Affiliate is eligible to serve only in appointive offices in the Section relating to activity of the Professional Technical Group or Groups with which he is affiliated.
- Sec. 5. An Affiliate shall not be entitled to any other rights or privileges which flow to IEEE members of any grade in the Section nor to vote for any candidate to elective office in the Section including Professional Technical Group Activity, nor hold any such elective office.

#### Article IV - Territory

Sec. 1. The territory of the Section shall be as approved by the IEEE Executive Committee, and may be enlarged, reduced, or otherwise altered by the IEEE Executive Committee at any time.

( Sec. 2. The territory of the Princeton Section (this organization) shall consist of New Jersey Counties Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, and Somerset. ) 

#### Article V - Finances

Sec. 1. There shall be no Section dues.

Sec. 2. The ordinary expenses of the Section shall be defrayed by the funds supplied by the IEEE. Funds on hand in the Section treasury, from whatever source derived, are the property of the IEEE, and shall not be used for purposes other than the normal operations of the Section, without prior authorization of the IEEE Executive Committee.

Sec. 3. Emergency or extraordinary expenses may be provided for by voluntary contribution from the membership of the Section. A unanimous vote of the Section Executive Committee is required before such a request may be made.

Sec. 4. The Section may require nonmembers who wish to be placed on the mailing list for notices to pay in advance for the estimated cost of such notices.

#### Article VI - Officers

Sec. 1. The officers of the Section shall be a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and a Secretary-Treasurer.

- Sec. 2. The terms of office for all officers shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting, or as soon thereafter as the election result is determined, and shall end at the close of the next Annual Meeting, or as soon thereafter as the result of the election of new officers is determined, and in any case continue until their successors are duly elected and take office.
- Sec. 3. The terms of office set forth above shall be approximately one year and may exceed this interval only in the case where the date of the Annual Meeting is being changed and a continuation in office is necessary to effect the new schedule, or no successor has been elected or appointed.

#### Article VII - Management

- Sec. 1. There shall be a Section Executive Committee consisting of the officers, the Junior Past Chairman and Chairmen of all standing committees listed elsewhere in these Bylaws. All Technical Groups and professional Technical Group Chapters shall have representation on the Committee. The Chairman of each Subsection and other member of the Regional Committee residing within the territory of the Princeton Section shall be ex-officio members. The Chairman may appoint, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the above members of the Section Executive Committee, additional members to the Section Executive Committee from the Section membership.
- Sec. 2. The Chairman, responsible to the Section Executive Committee, shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Section. He shall preside at meetings of the Section and the Section Executive Committee and have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be provided for in these Bylaws, or as may be delegated to him by vote of the Section. In his absence, his duties shall be performed by the Vice Chairman.
- Sec. 3. The Secretary-Treasurer shall receive and deposit all monies in the name of the Section in such depository as shall be determined by the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such disbursements as shall be ordered by the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such reports as may be required by the IEEE Executive Committee. Section records shall be maintained by the Secretary-Treasurer. Financial reports shall be made to IEEE Headquarters on a calendar year basis.
- Sec. 4. The Secretary-Treasurer shall record the minutes of all meetings of the Section and of the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such reports of his activities as may be required by the IEEE Executive Committee.

Sec. 5 The Chairman, as soon as expedient after the Annual Meeting, shall appoint Chairmen of the following standing committees as required:

Program (Meetings and Paper) Committee  
Arrangements Committee  
Membership Committee  
Awards  
Publicity Committee  
P. S. Editor  
P. S. Business Manager  
Social Affairs Committee  
Visiting Speakers Committee  
Princeton University Representative  
Rutgers University Representative

The chairmen of the committees shall be appointed for a period of one (1) year. The number of members in a committee shall be determined by the committee chairman and shall be appointed by him.

The Vice Chairman shall be chairman of the Program Committee.

Members appointed shall serve until their successors are appointed or the Committee dissolved.

Other committees may be authorized by vote of the Section Executive Committee at any regular meeting. When a committee is no longer needed it may be discontinued by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Committee.

#### Article VIII - Nomination and Election of Officers

Sec. 1. All officers shall be elected at the Annual Meeting of the Section. There shall be a Nominating Committee consisting of the three (3) most recent Past Chairmen of the Princeton Section. The Junior Past Chairman will be the Chairman of the Nominating Committee. In the event that one or more of the three most recent Past Chairmen is unable to serve, the next most recent Past Chairman shall serve in his stead. The nominations submitted by the Nominating Committee shall be announced at least 45 days preceding the Annual Meeting. Nominations also may be made by qualified voters when supported by a petition signed by at least 10 percent or 10 voting members, whichever is least. Nominating petitions shall be submitted to the Nominating Committee prior to the deadline for the issue of P.S. announcing the Annual Meeting.

All nominations shall be announced in the notice of the Annual Meeting.

Sec. 2. When at an Annual Meeting there is more than one (1) nominee for any one of the officers of Chairman, Vice Chairman, or Secretary-Treasurer, the Chairman of the Section may conduct the election at the Annual Meeting if it is evident that a fair expression of the wishes of the membership can be then determined. As an alternative, he may announce that the results shall be determined by a letter ballot. When at an Annual Meeting there is only one (1) nominee for each of the offices of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary-Treasurer, the Chairman of the Section shall instruct the Secretary-Treasurer to cast a unanimous vote for the nominees presented by the Nominating Committee.

Sec. 3. In the event that election of officers is to be determined by letter ballot, the Secretary-Treasurer shall provide promptly to each voting member of the Section a letter ballot with return envelope with a return date specified, which shall in no case be later than six weeks after date of the Annual Meeting.

The Chairman shall call a meeting of the Section Executive Committee to appoint a Tellers Committee to count the vote and determine the successful candidates.

The Chairman shall inform the successful candidates of their election and arrange for the transfer of responsibility to the new officers without delay.

Sec. 4. Vacancies in office occurring during the year shall be filled by the Section Executive Committee for the remainder of the unexpired term unless otherwise provided for.

Sec. 5. If for any reason the best interests of the Section seem to require a change in the governing body during the year, the matter shall be duly and carefully considered by the Section Executive Committee. Upon not less than two-thirds vote of the Section Executive Committee, or upon receipt by the Section Executive Committee of a petition signed by fifteen (15) members of the Section, recommendation shall be made to the Section for action at a special meeting to be duly called by the Section Executive Committee for the sole purpose of considering and voting upon such a change.

A two-thirds vote of the members present shall be necessary to declare an office vacant. Upon two-thirds vote of the members present, the vacant office may be filled for the unexpired term. Nominations for the vacant office may be received from the floor.

#### Article IX - Meetings

Sec. 1. The Section shall not hold less than five regular meetings during the year, one of which shall be an Annual Meeting.

Sec. 2. The Annual Meeting shall be held in April or May, depending on program arrangements.

- Sec. 3. The start of the administrative year of the Section shall be July 1.
- Sec. 4. At least 25 members shall be present to constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section called for the transaction of regular business and requiring a vote to be taken.
- Sec. 5. A majority of the votes cast, a quorum being present, is necessary for the election of officers.
- Sec. 6. Meetings of the Section Executive Committee shall be held at such times as shall be found necessary. Section Executive Committee meetings may be called by the Chairman of the Section at his own discretion or shall be at the request of three members of the Committee.
- Sec. 7. Two-thirds of the members of the Section Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section Executive Committee, except as otherwise provided herein.
- Sec. 8. A majority vote of the Section Executive Committee, a quorum being present, shall be necessary in the conduct of its business except as otherwise provided in these Section Bylaws.
- Sec. 9. Notice of all regular section meetings shall be sent to all members.

#### Article X - Publications

- Sec. 1. This Section may publish a periodical named the "P.S." which will be the major medium of communication with the Section membership. This periodical may accept advertising, which must be of a technical nature or have a special interest to IEEE members.

#### Article XI - Amendments

- Sec. 1. Proposed amendments to these Bylaws shall be submitted to the IEEE Section Executive Committee, and shall become effective when acted on in conformity with the IEEE Constitution for Sections.

#### Article XII - Section Dissolution

- Sec. 1. Should a section be dissolved for any reason whatever, all the assets, of whatever nature, shall revert to the IEEE.
