Dear Ron:

Now that the IRE Board of Directors and the AIEE Board of Directors, respectively on October 18 and 20, have approved proceeding with work essential to the development of a plan for consolidation of the two organizations, I have been asked to advise you of your appointment as the IRE representative to two... two-man... study committees.

One committee area is Extra Society Relationships, and your AIEE counterpart will be Mr. T.M. Linville, General Electric Company, 1147 Wendell Avenue, Schenectady, New York.

One committee area is International Activities, and your AIEE counterpart will be Mr. J.W. Feste, Commonwealth Associates, Inc., 269 East Washington Street, Jackson, Michigan.

As you know, to accomplish the necessary work on the time scale envisioned by the two Boards, the two-man study committees are being asked to meet and to develop, within the next two weeks, guidelines on their assigned subject which can serve as a basis for a meeting within three weeks of the four-man committee responsible for initial development of a draft of a new constitution and new by-laws.

It was agreed by the two Boards that the IRE representative of each of the two-man committees would contact the AIEE representative and arrange a get-together. We would, therefore, greatly appreciate your arranging to meet with Mr. Linville at a mutually convenient time on "extra society relationships" and with Mr. Feste at a mutually convenient time on "international activities."
