UEC PLEDGES

If there should be occasion at the annual meeting of UET, you may report the following effort on the part of AIEE to collect overdue pledges to the UEC Building Fund.

Beginning in August 1962, AIEE reviewed the list of its members whose pledges had not been paid, and were overdue. It was found that, of 1,294 such accounts, 1,195 offered some prospect of a return. Letters of appeal and statements were sent to these.

At the same time, a list of delinquent accounts of active members was sent to each Section with a request for a follow-up.

A tabulation of the number and total of such accounts for each Section was made and circulated to the Sections and certain officers of the Institute.

The results to date are as follows:
