Dear Mr. Al-Dashash,

Today I must address again the request of your Jeddah Subsection to become an independent IEEE section.

I am sorry to say that this activity does not make me very happy. I understand that Saudi Arabia is a very large territory with lots of desert in the center, and therefore not too much connections between its different centers of engineering activities. On the other hand there is not so much activity going on or to be expected, that it could not be handled very well by the presently developing subsection structure within one full section.

I am very glad to have one person to speak for the whole Kingdom so far in our regional committee. There is just one section in any other country of Region 8 aside of Italy. Our largest sections as UKRI, Benelux, Switzerland have between 1500 and 3000 members each, up to 10 active chapters and up to 3 languages spoken within one section territory. There would be a possibility to form an Arabian or Middle East Area some time in the future but also this does not seem to me feasible at the present state of society development and ongoing activities in your area.

A more realistic way could be to shift the section headquarter from Dhahran more to the center in Riyadh.

You should try to meet with three chairpersons of the East, Central and West district and work out a good proposal, telling what is your technical and organisational goal, what you want to improve and to make more efficient.

We certainly will not be able to invite and finance more than one representative of your country to our regional meetings twice a year. On the other hand there must be a good connection with the trans-national environment for each section well-secured.

Thank you very much for your letter of March 13, 1987 regarding approval for formation of IEEE Jeddah subsection. I am pleased to learn that the record of all IEEE members, residing within the Jeddah subsection territorial limits are being modified to reflect the formation of this subsection. I shall be obliged if mailing labels for these members could be prepared and sent, to facilitate our future meetings and activities announcements communications.

A recent review of the geographical boundaries of the Jeddah subsection revealed that 42° longitude does not include the cities of ABHA and NAJRAN. Mr. Ken. E. Stevens and myself, are of the opinion that the Jeddah subsection boundaries should be re-defined as under:

" Starting at the north border at 42° longitude, continuing along to 25° latitude. Then south east to the south border at 46° longitude".

The first meeting of the Jeddah subsection was held on March 11, 1987 in the premises of a local Cable manufacturing facility - The Saudi Cable Company. The meeting was attended and partly conducted by the Saudi Arabian section chairman Mr. Ken. E. Stevens. 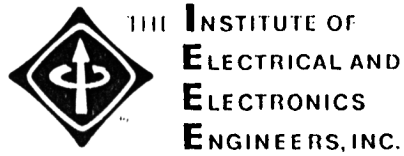

The first meeting of the IEEE Jeddah subsection has been arranged to take place as follows:

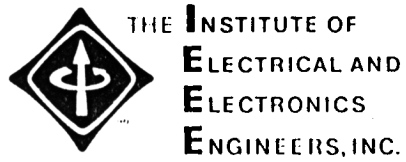
