Apologies are extended for this delay in responding to your note on the bottom of G. H. Edwards' letter of August 22 to you, but at least at this time I can advise that I think we can live with the arrangement suggested in his letter. While it is not the arrangement that we would prefer, I do not feel we can or should press the subject further in view of the exception that was made for the Boston, Lynn and Providence Sections (Page 143 of the 1960-61 Organization Manual) but it is a fair compromise. Basically our problem is with the original assignment of members to a new Section, new admissions to the Institute, and members transferring from Section to Section as their employment requires. If we had to measure how many miles a man lived from a certain datum point on Grand Coulee Dam, or determine within a town which members are north and which south of Highway 2, it could become tedious and possibly inaccurrate. While this one situation undoubtedly would not involve too much pain, I can foresee that once the precedent is established it might be a basis for similar "difficult" boundaries of numerous new Sections. Our problems would then multiply rapidly and the description of the boundaries in the Organization Manual, or its successor, would grow and grow and grow.

Therefore, as soon as you give final approval we will reassign to the Wenatchee Section those members with addresses in the Washington Counties of Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant, with the exception of Coulee Dam, Coulee City, Grand Coulee, and Electric City.

Will the effective date still be September 1 or do you choose to designate a later date?

Thank you very much for your letter of August 13th giving us more details regarding the formation of the Wenatchee Section. With reference to your paragraph \$1 we are pleased to see that there were a total of 52 petitioners in the area that you wish to use for your new Section status which would qualify the new arrangement. I did want to have a complete clarification regarding the Coulee Dam Members before putting the final approval on this part of the procedure.

Relative to the county allocation it would be my suggestion that the new Wenatchee Section would include the following counties in the State of Washington: Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant with the exception of Coulee Dam, Coulee City and Grand Coulee which will remain in the Spokane Section. It is to be noted that Coulee Dam is listed as being in Douglas, Grand and Okanogan Counties. I believe this would give Headquarters the definition they will need for mailing purposes and eliminate the need for using Highway \$2 as an identification point. By copy of this letter to Mr. J. J. Anderson at Headquarters, I am going to ask him to review the original geographical definition on this basis and let us know whether that will be satisfactory to them.

I have received a copy of your letter of August 8th to Mr. Wright regarding the Wenatchee Section's petition. On the original petition, Mr. E. A. Benson was the only member at Coulee Dam that signed the petition for Section status, therefore, we do not believe additional signatures on the petition are required since this brings our total to 52 instead of 53. We had purposely omitted the Coulee Dam members because we felt they would prefer to belong to the Spokane Section.

We also have received a copy of your letter of August 10th regarding the original county allocation of the Wenatchee Sub-section as compared to the new proposed Section geographic outlines. The original Sub-section territory was the same as the boundaries of the following counties in the State of Washington: Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant, with the exception of an area with a 20 mile radius from Grand Coulee. This was also the territory as described on the Section Petition. This description places Coulee Dam (Okanogan County) in the Spokane Section. As there are no other large communities with A.I.E.E. members within 20 miles of Grand Coulee (Dam) lying north of Highway 2 in Grant County, we have felt the original territory description was reasonable and best suited the mutual interest of the Wenatchee and Spokane A.I.E.E. groups. We, therefore, omitted the Coulee Dam area members from our Section Petition, and their subsequent written request to remain in the Spokane Section confirmed our thinking. The Spokane Section suggested omitting the area north of Highway #2 in Grant County and Coulee Dam in Okanogan County from the Wenatchee Section Territory as being a recommendation from "National" after the June Denver meeting.

With this revision, I would urge favorable consideration of the Wenatchee application.



Apologies are extended for this delay in responding to your note on the bottom of G. H. Edwards' letter of August 22 to you, but at least at this time I can advise that I think we can live with the arrangement suggested in his letter. While it is not the arrangement that we would prefer, I do not feel we can or should press the subject further in view of the exception that was made for the Boston, Lynn and Providence Sections (Page 143 of the 1960-61 Organization Manual) but it is a fair compromise. Basically our problem is with the original assignment of members to a new Section, new admissions to the Institute, and members transferring from Section to Section as their employment requires. If we had to measure how many miles a man lived from a certain datum point on Grand Coulee Dam, or determine within a town which members are north and which south of Highway 2, it could become tedious and possibly inaccurrate. While this one situation undoubtedly would not involve too much pain, I can foresee that once the precedent is established it might be a basis for similar "difficult" boundaries of numerous new Sections. Our problems would then multiply rapidly and the description of the boundaries in the Organization Manual, or its successor, would grow and grow and grow.

Therefore, as soon as you give final approval we will reassign to the Wenatchee Section those members with addresses in the Washington Counties of Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant, with the exception of Coulee Dam, Coulee City, Grand Coulee, and Electric City.

This will acknowledge your letter of August 17, 1962 regarding the county allocation of the Wenatchee Section. Your suggestion that the new Wenatchee Section include the following counties in the State of Washington: Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant with the exception of Coules Dam, Coules City and Grand Coules which would remain in the Spokane Section is acceptable and agreeable with us. We would also suggest Electric City in Grant County be included to belong to the Spokane Section. This appears to be a simpler method of territory division between Wenatchee and Spokane Sections for National to administer.

Dear Mr. Edwards,

Thank you very much for your letter of August 13th giving us more details regarding the formation of the Wenatchee Section. With reference to your paragraph #1 we are pleased to see that there were a total of 52 petitioners in the area that you wish to use for your new Section status which would qualify the new arrangement. I did want to have a complete clarification regarding the Coulee Dam Members before putting the final approval on this part of the procedure.

Relative to the county allocation it would be my suggestion that the new Wenatchee Section would include the following counties in the State of Washington: Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant with the exception of Coulee Dam, Coulee City and Grand Coulee which will remain in the Spokane Section. It is to be noted that Coulee Dam is listed as being in Douglas, Grand and Okanogan Counties. I believe this would give Headquarters the definition they will need for mailing purposes and eliminate the need for using Highway #2 as an identification point. By copy of this letter to Mr. J. J. I have received a copy of your letter of August 8th to Mr. Wright regarding the Wenatchee Section's petition. On the original petition, Mr. E. A. Benson was the only member at Coulee Dam that signed the petition for Section status, therefore, we do not believe additional signatures on the petition are required since this brings our total to 52 instead of 53. We had purposely omitted the Coulee Dam members because we felt they would prefer to belong to the Spokane Section.

We also have received a copy of your letter of August 10th regarding the original county allocation of the Wenatchee Sub-section as compared to the new proposed Section geographic outlines. The original Sub-section territory was the same as the boundaries of the following counties in the State of Washington: Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant, with the exception of an area with a 20 mile radius from Grand Coulee. This was also the territory as described on the Section Petition. This description places Coulee Dam (Okanogan County) in the Spokane Section. As there are no other large communities with A.I.E.E. members within 20 miles of Grand Coulee (Dam) lying north of Highway 2 in Grant County, we have felt the original territory description was reasonable and best suited the mutual interest of the Wenatchee and Spokane A.I.E.E. groups. We, therefore, omitted the Coulee Dam area members from our Section Petition, and their subsequent written request to remain in the Spokane Section confirmed our thinking. The Spokane Section suggested omitting the area north of Highway #2 in Grant County and Coulee Dam in Okanogan County from the Wenatchee Section Territory as being a recommendation from "National" after the June Denver meeting.

We are agreeable to any reasonable suggestions to expedite the approval of the Petition. It is still our thinking that the simplest and easiest to administer both by National and the Sections is the original Sub-section territory as described on our original petition.








WASHINGTON MAP OF



In response to your inquiry of June 1 I am pleased to certify that the gentlemen named on the petition for the formation of the Wenatchee Section are members in good standing and therefore, their petition is in order.

However, the desired boundaries of the proposed Section, as indicated on the petition, caused some concern here at Headquarters with regard to coding the membership cards. The boundaries of Subsections are entirely within the control of Sections - but with the change to Section status the Institute records are involved. Bylaw 30.033 states that Section territories are defined by county line boundaries. Thus the "exception of an area with a 20 mile radius from Grand Coulee" in Grant County is of concern to us.

EXTRACTS FROM AIEE CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

Constitution

C56. Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, a sufficient number of Fellows, Members and Associate Members shall petition, in writing, these members may form, subject to the Constitution and all By-laws and regulations which may be hereafter prescribed by the Board of Directors, a Section organization for the purpose of more effectually carrying out the aims of the Institute.

C63. Any Section may adopt for its own government such Bylaws to be known as "Section Bylaws" as it may find expedient, provided that no provision thereof shall be incompatible with the Constitution or the Bylaws of the Institute.

Bylaws

B40. A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed, on a form provided by Institute Headquarters, by not less than 50 members residing within the territorial limits hereinafter prescribed. The Board of Directors may decline to authorize the formation of a Section when in its judgment such an organization would not be compatible with the interests of the Institute.

- B41. In the initial Section organization only petitioners shall have the right to vote.
- B45. The territory of a Section shall be defined, wherever practical, by county line boundaries.

Territorial assignments for the establishment of new Sections or reassignment of Section territories shall be subject to the concurrence of the Sections and Vice-Presidents involved, and the Sections Committee.

B49. A Section whose membership has become 30 or less as of August first, or a Section which shall have held less than four meetings in any fiscal year (May 1 through April 30), shall be formally advised by the Secretary that, if within the next year this situation has not been materially improved, such Section shall become a Subsection (or Division), effective October 1. The Vice-President of the District shall recommend to the Sections Committee the Section to which the Subsection (or Division) shall be assigned.

The Board of Directors may at any time terminate the existence of any Section when in its judgment the interests of the Institute make such action desirable.

It is with a great deal of pleasure that I wish to advise you I am attaching hereto our completed petition form for Section Status in the American Institute of Electrical Engineers for the Wenatchee Subsection. To expedite the obtaining of signatures, copies of the original Form No. 250 were circulated to the members. As you know, our proposed Section Territory includes Chelan, Kittitas, Okanogan, Douglas and Grant Counties, which made it difficult to personally contact each member before this A.I.E.E. year expired.

We wish to emphasize our interest and desire for obtaining an A.I.E.E. Section in Wenatchee. At the present time and for many years past, the Wenatchee Subsection of A.I.E.E. has been the only engineering technical organization in the North Central Washington area, and as such has served a real community need and has been able to perform a true technical service to the area. Wenatchee, being centrally located, has been a natural center for the growth of a Subsection in this area. Section status will not only add prestige to the organization but will provide additional finances and impetus to enable our local organization to better serve the technical and engineering needs of our members and provide the technical leadership in this area.

The territory included in our petition is exceptionally deserving to have a full Section of A.I.E.E. There are four hydroelectric projects on the Columbia River operated by Public Utility Districts, one Federal Project and
