3. THE VANCOUVER SECTION EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE HAS AGREED TO RELEASE THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO THE NEW SECTION.
4. THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR OF REGION 8 ENDORSES THE PETITION, AS SUBMITTED.
5. IF PETITION IS APPROVED, THE PROPOSED SECTION AGREES TO ABIDE BY THE CONSTITUTION FOR SECTIONS.


Dear Mr. Greenaway:


Dear Mr. McRae:

You will recall previous correspondence with Mr. H. Gissing, the past Secretary-Treasurer of the Winnipeg Subsection, relating to the proposed formation of a full section here. At that time, the only point for negotiation with other sections was the proposed boundaries of the new Winnipeg Section.


We have now decided that for the present the Section's eastern boundary should be the provincial boundary line separating Manitoba and Ontario, and the western boundary should be the provincial boundary line separating Saskatchewan and Alberta, and we herewith enclose letters from the executives of the Toronto and Vancouver Sections indicating their agreement to this proposal. Dr. Henderson, the Regional Director, is being asked to forward his approval directly to you.

A petition, signed by twenty-nine members and associate members of our present Subsection, asking for the formation of a Section is also enclosed. These members are all residents of Winnipeg and it's suburbs, and in number they represent approximately fifty percent of the total membership. Due to the vacation season, it was not possible to contact a greater percentage of the membership.







WE ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF YOUR LETTER DATED JULY 2 WITH REFERENCE TO A CHANGE IN STATUS OF THE WINNIPEG SUBSECTION OF THE TORONTO SECTION TO A FULL IRE SECTION.

WE NOTE THAT YOU PLAN TO APPROACH THE IRE MEMBERS RESIDING IN FORT ARTHUR, FORT WILLIAMS AND SASKATCHEWAN TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE IN FAVOR OF COMING IN WITH THE NEW WINNIPEG SECTION. OUR RECORDS SHOW THAT THERE ARE ONLY THREE IRE MEMBERS RESIDING IN THIS TERRITORY, AND WE ARE ENCLOSED HEREBY 3" X 5" CARDS WITH THEIR NAMES AND ADDRESSES.

THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE TO BE FULFILLED IN SUBMITTING THE PETITION:

- 1) A PETITION SIGNED BY NOT LESS THAN 25 MEMBERS OF ASSOCIATE GRADE OR HIGHER, WHO HAVE PROCEEDINGS MAILING ADDRESSES WITHIN THE TERRITORY OF THE PROPOSED SECTION, MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
- 2) THE PETITION SHOULD INDICATE THE TERRITORY TO BE INCLUDED IN THIS PROPOSED SECTION
- 3) IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR YOU TO NEGOTIATE WITH WHATEVER SECTION OR SECTIONS NOW SERVE THE PROPOSED TERRITORY OF THE NEW WINNIPEG SECTION IN ORDER TO GET THEIR PERMISSION TO TRANSFER ANY TERRITORY TO YOUR PROPOSED SECTION. SUCH APPROVAL, BY WHATEVER SECTIONS ARE INVOLVED, SHOULD BE INDICATED IN WRITING BY THE OFFICERS OF THOSE SECTIONS AT THE TIME THE PETITION IS SUBMITTED, AS WELL AS WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR.
- 4) IT WILL FURTHER BE NECESSARY FOR THE PROPOSED SECTION TO INDICATE IN WRITING THAT THEY WILL ABIDE BY THE CONSTITUTION FOR SECTIONS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. A COPY OF THIS CONSTITUTION IS ENCLOSED.

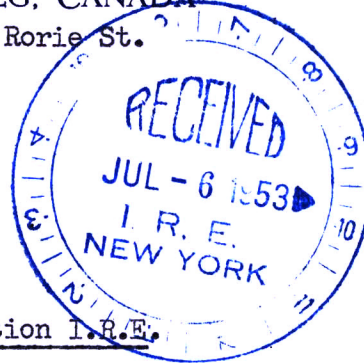

Subject: Formation of Winnipeg Section I.R.E.

Attention: Mr. J. W. McRae, President.

Dear Mr. McRae:

At one of our Winnipeg I.R.E. Meetings several months' ago, the question was raised by some of the members as to forming a full section of the I.R.E. at Winnipeg.

On putting this to a vote of members it was found that practically 100% of the members were in favor of taking immediate steps towards the formation of such a section.

Before proceeding any further on this however, we approached both the Toronto Section and the Vancouver Section with particular reference as to the subdivision of territory.

I am attaching hereto a copy of Mr. McCurdy's letter of June 3rd, wherein you note they are in agreement with the formation of a separate section at Winnipeg, except for the settlement of the boundary.

We, at Winnipeg, believe that Port Arthur and Fort William should be included in our territory, due to its geographical location and we put forward this suggestion to the Toronto section.

Mr. McCurdy's letter of June 3rd, suggests that the logical boundary would be the Manitoba-Ontario border and, with particular reference to Port Arthur and Fort William, has suggested that the decision, as to the section under which they would like to operate, should be left to a vote of the members in Port Arthur and Fort William.

We believe this is an excellent and fair suggestion and would be willing to abide by such a decision.

Tentatively, therefore, we would like to consider the Manitoba-Ontario border as our Eastern boundary, except that we would like to have the names and addresses of any members residing in Port Arthur and Fort William so they could be approached on the suggestion put forth by Mr. McCurdy and, from their replies, determine whether the majority are in favor of coming

in with the Winnipeg Section or remaining with the Toronto Section.

With reference to our Western boundary, you will note from Mr. Gregory's letter of April 2nd that they are in agreement in that Saskatchewan should be included with our territory and Alberta and B.C. remain in the B.C. district.


If there are no other objections to this we would like to have a list of the members in Saskatchewan so that we can contact them and outline the proposal being put forward to forming the full section at Winnipeg and ensure they are in agreement with this proposal.

On the basis of the above, we would like to take this opportunity of entering the request for consideration as to forming a separate full section of the I.R.E. at Winnipeg.

We have had a very successful year, particularly with respect to the obtaining of new members and we feel that, by being a full section, there would be more inducement for obtaining additional members in Manitoba and, through our association and dealings with people such as the faculty of the University of Saskatchewan at Saskatoon, in the near future we could organize other subsections possibly at Saskatoon and Regina, but this could only be done by us if we were operating as a full section.

After our request has been processed by the committee we would appreciate hearing from you on this matter as, although we have officially terminated our meetings for 1952-53, we would nevertheless like to start out new sessions in September as a full section.

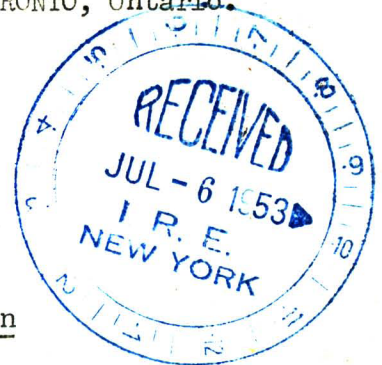

Dear Sirs:

Further to your letter of June 1st, I have talked the matter over with Mr. Jack Bain, the new Toronto Chairman of the I.R.E., who will be handling this matter from now on.

During our discussion this morning and a previous discussion with Dr. Henderson, it was agreed that a fair solution to the problem of boundaries between Toronto and Winnipeg would be to let the people concerned in Port Arthur and Fort William vote on the matter, to decide to which Section they would like to belong. There is not a desire on our part to interfere with the decision of these people, however, our feeling is that they should be able to decide for themselves, rather than be told by us where they are going to belong.

The logical boundary would be the Manitoba, Ontario border, and it is for this reason that we bring this matter up rather than agree with you, before consulting the people concerned. If you will indicate your wishes along this line, we will take steps immediately to get the matter straightened out for you.

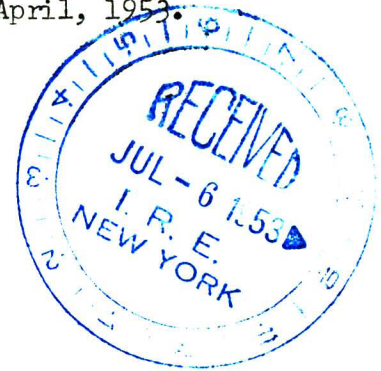

Your letter of April 13 has undoubtedly crossed mine to Mr. Tinkler, a copy of which was sent to you. In it I expressed my opinion that it would be greatly to everyone's advantage if the Winnipeg Sub-Section became the Winnipeg Section of the I.R.E.

It seems to me that the division of territory which you have outlined is the logical one and so long as Fort William and Port Arthur were included in your Section area I would believe that the Eastern boundary of your territory could be at any point convenient to you and the Toronto Section. Probably the easiest way to do this would be to define your eastern boundary as the provincial boundary line between Manitoba and Ontario except that the counties in Western Ontario which include Fort William and Port Arthur would be designated as part of the Winnipeg Section.
