MINUTES OF CLEAR LAKE SUBSECTION EXECUTIVE MEETING
OF
NOVEMBER 9, 1970

The Executive Meeting was held at the Holiday Inn on NASA Rd. 1 at 5:15 p.m. Ralph Sawyer, Subsection Chairman, called the meeting to order and presented the agenda.

The names of the nominating committee for next term subsection officers were presented. These names were:

Max Engert John Gorman Paul Howley Tex Fancher Roy Lang Bill Klenk NASA Philco Ford GE Boeing Lockheed TRW

It was noted that time for election of new officers was short if an orderly transfer is to be insured. Therefore, a meeting of the Nominating Committee was called at 5:15 p.m. on November 10th, before the subsection meeting.

It was pointed out that the section officers serve from June to June, rather than from January to January as we do. Discussion ensued relative to the merits of the two transition times. The January changeover works a severe disadvantage on the new program chairman, it was observed. A motion was made to keep the January transition. The motion failed to carry. Then a motion was made and seconded that:

- 1. The by-laws be reviewed relative to changing the time of officer election.
- 2. The question be put to the membership at the November 10th meeting, by-laws permitting.
- 3. It be the recommendation of executive committee that the June date be adopted and that this be implemented by the next slate of officers serving 17 months.

The motion carried, a quorum being present.

Ralph indicated that he had contacted Dr. Rochelle, Chairman of the National Telemetry Conference (NTC) relative to commitment to the Shamrock Hotel for the NTC '72. Dr. Rochelle insisted that there was no firm commitment. However, from the discussion, Ralph felt that there was really a moral commitment.

Additional NTC information was handed out and a discussion of the event followed. It was felt that there should be a NTC '72 executive committee separate from the subsection, although it was understood the subsection must carry much of the load. The importance of early organization, of topic selection, of the ladies program and of timely publicity was noted. A desire to involve petrochemical, medical and oceanographic interests was expressed. No specific action was taken.

The minutes of the last meeting were read. No objection was voiced.

The treasurer's report indicated a resolution of the problem with the parent section. The subsection president and treasurer met with the section officers at their last meeting. A request was placed for \$500.00 in operating expense. Section objected to advertising other than in the Pocketscope, but could not make a strong case in view of its tardy arrival last month. Section agreed to pay the subsection \$42.00 per meeting.

The Arrangements Chairman stated that shortages from the September meeting had been satisfactorily resolved and presented an accounting to the Chairman. The December meeting will involve a bus trip to Galveston. In view of this expense it was indicated that checks would be required with reservations.

The meeting was adjourned.
