REQUIREMENTS TO ESTABLISH AN IEEE SECTION/SUBSECTION

2. The petition must be signed by fifty (50) members for Section formation and twenty (20) members for Subsection formation, other than Student Grade, having IEEE mailing addresses within the territorial limits of the proposed Section/Subsection.
