Dear Mr. Schindler:

Thank you for your letter of February 1 and the detailed comments on the annual roster and membership listing by employees on our current file.

We had, as you indicated, maintained company information by members, but it is unfortunately not up-to-date. The reason for this is that in the past we have solicited company addresses every two years when the IEEE Membership Directory is mailed and we are acutely aware of the infalabilities of that system.

IEEE is developing a new data base and new procedures that will solve the company address problem. Essentially, we are compiling a two-address membership file whereby we can maintain both an individual member's home and company address. At the same time, we are reviewing our procedures and will be making necessary changes to actually maintain both addresses. As an example, when a member's home address changes, we will also solicit any change of address information for the company file.

I believe the capabilities of our new data base and revised operating procedures will be wholly responsive to the concerns expressed in your letter.

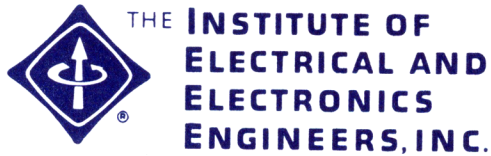

Your recent transmittal of the Annual Membership Roster has prompted me to fulfill a commitment I made to the Cleveland Section Executive Committee. At our November meeting we discussed our inability to get an accurate roster of our membership, grouped by employer. Ever since the Institute stopped requesting employer information from members, the amount of the information in the data bank has decreased and what is available has become woefully inaccurate. The Committee requested that I bring the problem up at the November Region 2 meeting in Pittsburg.

At the Region 2 meeting the Director informed me that the Institute's decision to stop maintaining employer information was based upon the costs associated with storing the additional information in the data bank and making changes, either annually or as reported by members.

At our December Executive Committee meeting the general concensus was that the above answer was the usual Institute "song and dance." I was charged with writing the Institute, officially putting the Cleveland Section on record as strongly in favor of the ability to obtain membership rosters by employer.

If it is necessary to limit the membership data which is available, we prefer that the Institute drop the work, plant, job function and category codes. Another alternative would be to make the charges for all roster listings commensurate with the costs to the Institute.

The Roster which I recently received will be used by the Cleveland Section but is of limited value to us. All we are able to do is scan the Roster to pick up likely candidates for committee work or other purposes. Since our list is printed on about 300 pages, the cost to duplicate it and give copies to the officers or committee chairmen is excessive.

In the past few years we have had problems getting or keeping some chapters or societies active and healthy. Since certain companies' principal work functions would indicate members who should be interested in the meetings of a particular chapter or society, it would be helpful to obtain lists of all members employed by those companies.

Similarly, we would like to be able to provide our plant representatives with lists of all members who work for their employer. This would help them keep those members better informed. It would also permit us to use Plant Reps more effectively when we are trying to stimulate interest for a particular meeting. Finally, it will help them identify key men who can help them promote IEEE, as well as promote additional members by more definitely determining who are already members.

It would be easy for us to tell you to save costs by eliminating the present roster entirely, since it is of limited value to us. But, in truth, we feel the most "cost-effective" solution is to make the Roster more usable by obtaining employer information and by making possible the ability to obtain rosters, segregated by employer.

This request may very well be the Cleveland Section's #1 priority for the Institute.

EXTRACT FROM THE CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE IX.

INSTITUTE SECTIONS AND BRANCHES

54. Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, a sufficient number of Fellows, Members and Associates shall petition, in writing, these members may form, subject to the Constitution and all By-laws and regulations which may be hereafter prescribed by the Board of Directors, a Section organization for the purpose of more effectually carrying out the aims of the INSTITUTE.

EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS

SEC. 36. A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed by not less than 25 members residing within the territorial limits hereinafter prescribed. The Board of Directors may decline to authorize the formation of a Section when in its judgment such an organization would not be compatible with the interests of the INSTITUTE.

SEC. 37. In the initial Section organization only petitioners shall have the right to vote.

SEC. 41. The territory of a Section shall include the locality naturally tributary thereto, but shall not include territory so remote or inaccessible that members cannot readily attend meetings. For the purpose of determining the maximum amount to which a Section is entitled under these By-laws, points more than sixty miles from the regular meeting place of the Section shall not be considered a part of that Section, except that, when special conditions warrant such action, additional territory within a reasonable distance may be authorized by the Board of Directors, upon approval of the Sections and Finance Committees. If adjacent Sections are so situated that the sixty-mile limit embraces common territory, the question as to which Section may claim such members as reside within this common territory shall if possible be decided by agreement between the Sections concerned, otherwise by the Sections Committee.

SEC. 42. In addition to INSTITUTE members the Section by-laws may admit other persons interested in engineering, who shall have all the Section privileges except those of voting and holding office.

Dear Sirs:

The 28 Fellows, Members and Associates of the American Institute of Electrical Engineers, whose signatures appear on the attached sheets and all of whom reside in Mansfield, Ohio, and its immediate vicinity, are desirous of organizing a Section at Mansfield, Ohio, and respectfully request the necessary authorization to establish such Section.

The following history of our present organization here and facts concerning the area to be served are given as supporting evidence to this petition.

For a number of years the AIEE members in Mansfield have felt the need of some organization in the city which could hold regular meetings and thus provide the benefits which are enjoyed by members residing in cities with regular Sections. Last fall, the question was again brought up of organizing in Mansfield and the problem was discussed with the officers of the Cleveland Section.

Shortly after this discussion, a survey was made of the interest in organizing here, and of 17 members interviewed all expressed themselves as being enthusiastically in favor of some form of organization.

The results of this survey were reported to a combined meeting of the Executive Committee and Advisory Board of the Cleveland Section, held on October 6. At this meeting, full approval was given to the plan of organizing a Mansfield Division of the Cleveland Section and a sum of \$50 was appropriated to foster the new Division's activities during the 1938-39 season.

The Cleveland Section held its first meeting of the current season in Mansfield on October 20, and at this meeting a temporary chairman was appointed to officially start the Mansfield Division. Incidentally, 70 members and guests from the Mansfield area attended this meeting.

Prior to the organization meeting the AIEE personnel in the district was sent a list of all members in the area and questionnaires which were intended to sound out their specific desires with regard to the functions and operation of the Division. The questionnaires asked how often meetings should be held, on what nights meetings could be attended, whether dinner or non-dinner meetings were preferred, how far in advance of meetings the notices should be sent out, whether women should be invited to the meetings, whether other engineers in the vicinity should be invited to all meetings, how many talks, inspection trips and social evenings were desired in a season, what their preferences were on 41 specific subjects of talks and 42 places for inspection trips, what the Division should do besides having regular meetings and several other pertinent questions. More than 20 of the questionnaires were filled out in detail, and they provided an excellent starting point for the Division.

The official organization meeting of the Mansfield Division was held on December 5, and was attended by 52 members and guests. Following a talk on a military subject, the various points on the questionnaire were brought up for discussion. It was decided to hold a meeting every month from October through May, to hold meetings on Wednesday nights, to have one dinner meeting of a social nature each year, to invite other engineers to all meetings and to have four talks, two inspection trips, one forum meeting and one social evening per season. The members then elected a Chairman, Vice-Chairman (to head the Meetings and Papers Committee), a Secretary-Treasurer, and a Chairman of the Publicity and Attendance Committee.

The next meeting was held on January 11 and consisted of an inspection of a steel mill and a talk on the plant. This meeting was attended by 230 members and guests. The personnel of six committees was announced, including Meetings and Papers, Attendance and Publicity, Membership, By-Laws, Locating Other Engineers, and Extra-Functional Activities, the latter three to be temporary. It was also announced at this meeting that plans were underway to petition for a Section, and a number of signatures were secured on the petition blanks.

The latest meeting held, as of this writing, was on February 1, and was attended by 60 persons. The subject of this meeting was "Electrical Protective Devices".

The Extra-Functional Committee held a meeting also on February 1, and in its preliminary report recommended that technical meetings be open to all engineers, that forum meetings be held to subjects of general interest to the engineering profession, that advice be offered to prospective engineering students, and that a plan be considered for helping any unemployed engineers.

When the Mansfield Division was first organized there were 32 AIEE members in the Mansfield area. An intensive membership drive resulted in securing 35 applications, so that there are now 67 members and applicants in the area. There are many more prospects here, and it is expected that a reasonable increase in membership will be enjoyed as the membership drive continues.

Aside from the fact that we now have 67 in the organization, a group interested enough and large enough to support a section, we feel that the large number of companies which employ electrical engineers in this area assures us of having the necessary stability to guarantee a progressive, long-lived section. The large employers of electrical engineers include the North Electric Manufacturing Company, (Galion), Ohio Brass Company, Ideal Electric & Manufacturing Company and Westinghouse Electric & Manufacturing Company. Smaller employers include the Dominion Electrical Manufacturing Company, Empire Sheet & Tin Plate Company, Ohio Public Service Company, Mansfield Telephone Company, Hartman Electrical Manufacturing Company, Autocall Company (Shelby), Ohio Public Service Company (Ashland), Faultless Rubber Company (Ashland), and Ohio Electric Power Company (Marion).

The territory desired by the proposed Mansfield Section includes Marion, Morrow and Knox Counties (now in the Columbus Section), Crawford County (now in the Toledo Section), Richland County (now in the Cleveland Section) and Ashland County (now in the Akron Section).

In accordance with the rules of the Institute, we have written to all of these sections regarding the ceding of the counties we desire. Following are the communications from three of the sections, granting us the necessary permission:

January 12, 1939

"We are in receipt of your letter asking permission to include the AIEE members in Bucyrus, Crestline and Galion (all in Crawford County) in your mailing list from your Mansfield Division so that they might attend Institute meetings in this Section.

"The time is too short for us to call an Executive meeting to act upon this matter, but I can assure you that it will be permissible to include them in your mailing list and will take the responsibility for the Executive Committee's passing on this matter."

"A canvas of the members of the Executive Committee of the Cleveland Section, AIEE has brought a generally favorable reaction to the efforts you and your associates are making toward the organization of a Mansfield Section. We, of course, are not in a position to say whether or not you are ready to stand on your own as an independent section. That is something you, yourselves, will have to determine after giving consideration to all the questions involved, including the financial budget.

"We, in Cleveland, are glad to see the progress in membership and interest within the Mansfield area which suggests the desirability of forming a Mansfield Section and give our endorsement to such action whenever you feel sure that the time is ripe. In the meantime we are glad to have you continue as the Mansfield Division of the Cleveland Section for it gives us an opportunity to "point with pride" to one of the most active member groups in the Institute.

"Our continued cooperation is available to you, both in your local activities, as a Division of the Cleveland Section, and in your further plans for the organization of a Mansfield Section."

"The Advisory Committee of the Akron Section has unanimously approved solicitation of membership to the Mansfield Division from those members now in the Akron Section residing in Loudonville and Ashland (both in Ashland County). Since Wooster is equally distant from Mansfield and Akron but with somewhat better driving conditions to Mansfield you may feel free to consider this city if you so desire.

It is the desire of the Mansfield Division to become an official Section of the Institute before the close of the current 1938-39 season, and it would be very much appreciated, therefore, if action could be taken by the Executive Committee at its meeting in March.

All of the AIEE members in the Mansfield district who have signed the attached forms give their pledge that they will devote their best energies to the advancement of the Mansfield Section, if authorized, and to the AIEE at large.

Petition to Establish Cleveland Joint-Societies Chapter on Medical Imaging

Dear Ms. Kovacs,

As there is considerable academic and commercial activity in medical imaging in Cleveland, I propose to establish a new Cleveland chapter that is focused on this topic. In the same paradigm that *IEEE Transactions on Medical Imaging* is associated with several societies, the new chapter is to be affiliated with 4 societies:

1. Engineering in Medicine and Biology
2. Computer
3. Signal Processing
4. Nuclear and Plasma Sciences

The chapter's official name will be *ECSN Combined Societies Chapter* with the letters ECSN taken as the first letter of the names of the societies listed. Informally, the chapter may be referred to as Medical Imaging Cleveland. The administrative affiliation is to be with the Engineering in Medicine and Biology Society.

I believed the IEEE requirements for chapter formation have been satisfied as the table below includes 16 members of Cleveland section who are above student grade. This exceeds the minimum requirement of 13. In addition, these societies listed above are adequately represented, by the petitioners as three or more petitioners are members of each of these societies.

Dear IEEE Cleveland Section Chair and Officers:

This petition requests that IEEE Cleveland Section grant the formation of a Cleveland, Ohio Chapter of the Electron Device Society. As you may or may not know, the Northeast Ohio region is home to numerous activities of relevance to EDS, including world-class research in microsystems technology at NASA Glenn Research Center, Cleveland Clinic and Case Western Reserve University. Many engineers at these institutions are members of EDS, but unfortunately are not served at the local level because no local EDS chapter currently exists within this region. We feel that IEEE is missing out on a great opportunity to engage this population and the formation of a Cleveland Chapter of EDS can go along way in meeting this objective.

Because many newly formed chapters face difficult challenges in reaching a self sustaining level due to difficulties in achieving "critical mass" both in overall membership as well as within a leadership core, we further request that the Cleveland Chapter of EDS be permitted to form a joint chapter with the Cleveland Chapter of the Antennas and Propagation\Microwave Theory and Techniques (AP/MTT) Societies. Currently the jointly-organized Cleveland Chapter of AP/MTT chapter is a very active local chapter, organizing and sponsoring lectures and technical meeting throughout the greater Cleveland area. A number of our members, including several in the AP/MTT leadership core are also members of EDS. We have been told by numerous people that there is

synergy between AP/MTT and EDS in the area of wireless microsystems. Many of the researchers in the Northeast Ohio region are engaged in wireless microsystems development. Forming a joint AP/MTT/EDS chapter would uniquely serve this community in a way that separate chapters could not. Moreover, the joint chapter would have the resources and critical mass necessary to achieve long-term sustainability.

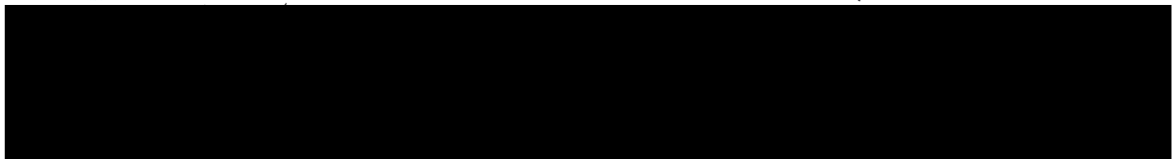
