Dear Mr. Dawson:

In reply to your letter of April 11 to Mr. G. W. Bailey regarding the report of the Subsection Committee to the Sections Committee on subsections. No comments have come to my attention since the Convention regarding this report. However, quite a lengthy discussion occurred at the sections meeting of March 3, with the final result that this report be embodied in the Section Manual until such time as the approved aspects of the principal parts are enabled by embodying them in the Section Bylaws or the Section Constitution or Institute Bylaws, and in the meantime, a paragraph be added pointing out that nothing embodied in the report is binding on any Section or Headquarter, but is an opinion only.

For your information, I am quoting below remarks of the various Sections on the report as they appear in a rough draft of the Section Committee Meeting Minutes which at present is in the hands of Mr. W. O. Swinyard for his approval.

"San Diego felt that the 30 member minimum, as suggested in the report, was too high. They pointed to their own trouble in getting enough members to sign the petition, and stated that as soon as they were formed, their membership tripled. It was suggested that a subsection might be formed with the idea that in one year it should have the specified members. Dayton favored an experimental stage, with the officializing of the subsection to follow when it appears self-supporting. Mr. Bailey then suggested that, as a subsection is responsible to their section, each section determine the number required to form its own subsection. Mr. Laeser pointed out that a 5 man subsection should not get a \$10 meeting allowance. Mr. Bailey stated that the Section should dole out the money accordingly, and suggested a \$5 meeting allowance for small Sub-Sections. This suggestion was supported by Cleveland. North Carolina - Virginia pointed out that if the limit is left up to the Section, they might be selfish about letting their membership go into a subsection, and suggested a minimum of 20 members. Mr. Laeser pointed out that the members in a subsection are still members of the Section. Chicago described their concept of a subsection as a committee nominated by the Executive Committee to organize local activity. As an example they reported that whereas South Bend had only 5 members originally, it now has 60 members. Mr. Heising pointed out that Mr. Laeser's report was merely an opinion and not binding to anyone, and thought it should be included in the Sections Manual."

Thank you for sending in your opinions on subsections. It is just such opinions as these that are important in forming a policy for all sections to follow with regard to subsections.

Dear George,

We have had a number of Meetings in our Section to consider the question of your March 3rd., Report of the Sub-section Committee to the Sections Committee on Sub-sections.

The general consensus of opinion among our Members was that in Section 1, a good basis would be to require 15 Members to start a Sub-section and require that there be 30 Members within the first year. It is agreed that the present minimum of 25 Members is too low for successful operation and we recommend a figure of 50 would be more successful.

The question of whether ten of the original Members should be of Member Grade or higher was thought to be excessive, at a start of the sub-section, but might be required after one year, although at the start it was agreed that at least the Executive should be of Member Grade or higher. The proposal of \$10 rebate per Meeting, up to a maximum of five Meetings, was felt to be quite satisfactory.

The proposal under paragraph 4 - finances - were agreed to with the exception that in section (b) it was felt that the division between sub-section and the section for Members affiliated with sub-sections, should be a 50-50 split instead of 75-25.

I think this sums-up the comments of our Section, and I would be very pleased to hear how these compare with the comments received from other sections.
