Dan Toland will be sending out a meeting summary soon, but here's what affects us:



1. Dissolution of the Middle Tennessee Section. Note, however, that the terminology to be used in any communication is that the Middle Tennessee Section was merged into the Nashville Section. The Region 3 folks are a little sensitive about this.
2. Dissolution of the Northeast Mississippi Subsection. No sensitivity here.
3. Bylaw approvals. I handled these, with Donna's kind assistance.
4. Formation of the Madhya Pradesh Subsection. Peg's on top of this.
5. Approval of Chapter Formations. Cuba's EDS Chapter was not formed, but we are not taking action until other issues have been resolved.
6. Bank Account Authorizations. Region Directors to receive an electronic update every three months.
7. Consolidation. Any unit with >\$200K in assets must submit their L-50 by the February deadline. Those L-50s will be processed within 30 days. If said L-50 cannot be APPROVED within 30 days, the status will be reported to the Treasurer, Chair, and Region Director.

Further, any above-mentioned L-50 for which it takes longer than 30 days to complete the missing information will result in an additional equal delay in the release of the rebate.

[Interpretation: If we get one of these L-50s in on time, but it's in such bad shape that it takes Rich six months to get everything needed, then we hold the rebate an additional six months.]

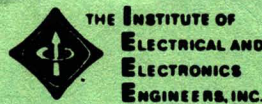

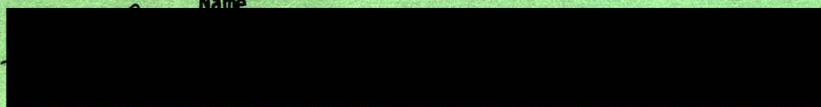
