Subj: Petition to Dissolve the Michiana Section

The Michiana Section has been inactive for some 7 years. It has failed to provide IEEE Regional Activities with the required New Officers Report, the Meetings Report and the Financial Report per Section 5.4.M of the RAB Operations Manual.

Several attempts have been made to reactivate the Section, but to no avail. I have made several contacts with past officers to attempt to form a core team to reactivate the Section. The Region 4 East Area Chair Don Bramlett has made recent contacts. And, our West Michigan Section leadership has been active in the area. We detect no Section operation and have found no one willing to take on the task of reactivation.

Don Bramlett is in contact with the Sections involved and has found support for the action as recommended below. He does note that in his contact with the Michiana Section "past Treasurer" Michael Stoll, there is a report of some Section financial support of a Student Branch. I have informed Don of the seriousness of this situation. RAD is aware of the status and Don is pursuing the matter with the direction to secure the funds as IEEE funds and to pursue long term support for the Student Branch.

I, therefore, petition RAB to invoke 5.4.N of the IEEE RAB Operations Manual and automatically dissolve the Michiana Section and reassign its members and territory within the boundaries of Michigan to the West Michigan Section and within the boundaries of Indiana to the Calumet Section.

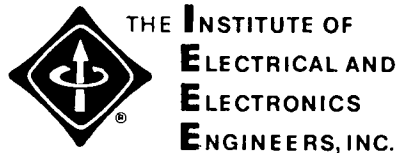
As soon as RAB approves this petition, The West Michigan Section and the Calumet Section will revise their respective bylaws and begin serving our members in these areas. With the securing of the funds of the Michiana Section satisfactory to IEEE, Region 4 is prepared to divide the remaining funds between the receiving Sections in proportion to their respective gains in membership.
