
You may possibly have heard about the reconstitution of our Kuwait Section after the liberation. Our Section has become active once again, and efforts to locate the Section members are intensely on.

Dear Fellow Al-Ghunaim:

Thank you for your recent interest in developing an IEEE organization in Kuwait, where there are many more than the required number (50) of members to establish a Section.

Enclosed are various IEEE documents to assist with the effort, including the petition forms (extra copies included) and a current list of active IEEE members. For petition purposes, we recommend that you try to obtain 60 or so signatures, even though 50 is the given requirement. Occasionally some non-current members may sign, forgetting they haven't paid current dues.

In the IEEE Bylaws enclosed, part 404.4 addresses the "exclusivity" of IEEE Sections. I would recommend that you discuss this matter, as it may apply to Kuwaiti procedures, with Region 8 Director Ohrvik and/or General Manager Eric Herz. (As you may know, IEEE has 2 Sections and 2 Subsections in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.) Surely there is a method of mutually beneficial establishment.

I am also enclosing a Chapter formation petition. Society Chapters may be formed concurrent with or subsequent to the official establishment of an IEEE Section. Again "shucran" for your interest in IEEE development. Please contact myself or any of your regional leaders (roster enclosed) if we can assist.
