Rationale for formation

IEEE Central Region Subsection

To be formed under the IEEE Sri Lanka section

IEEE Sri Lanka section was formed in 2004 and has an active membership of about 250. Most of the members are concentrated around the two major cities of Sri Lanka, namely Colombo and Kandy (is considered as the capital of Central Region), a large majority of them being in the Colombo area. Due to this high concentration of membership almost all the activities of the IEEE Sri Lanka section are conducted in and around Colombo. All the administration related activities such as conducting executive committee meetings too are held in Colombo.

Due to these reasons a large number of active members of IEEE Sri Lanka section who are around Kandy, and are willing to volunteer in IEEE activities find it difficult to take part in such activities due to the constraints of time and the expenses incurred in traveling to Colombo.

Taking the above into cognizance the active membership around Kandy has decided to petition the IEEE to form a subsection in Kandy.

This would enable us to conduct more IEEE activities around Kandy with the assistance of the Sri Lanka section, and with the organizing related help from members in Kandy. This will help us in satisfying the aspirations of the membership regarding the Continuous Professional Development (CPD) education needs. This is very important since other international institutions (such as IEE, CIMA) are actively engaged in conducting CPD activities. We have identified that CPD education activities is THE key attraction for an Engineer in Sri Lanka to continue to be a member of the professional organization to which he belongs, and in choosing an organization to join.

It would also enable the conducting of a strong membership development drive since a large number of persons eligible for IEEE membership live and work around Kandy.

This would also afford the networking opportunities for the large membership around Kandy.

It will also afford the IEEE members the opportunity to interact with the academics attached to the University of Peradeniya, located in Kandy, which has a large academic faculty concentrated on engineering and computer related disciplines. This would foster relations between the IEEE members working in industry and academia.

Considering all the above factors we are certain that the IEEE would accept our petition for the formation of a Kandy subsection under the IEEE Sri Lanka section.





















