I would appreciate receipt of the above items and information at your earliest convenience and hope that you can find it possible to have them in my hands prior to February 18.

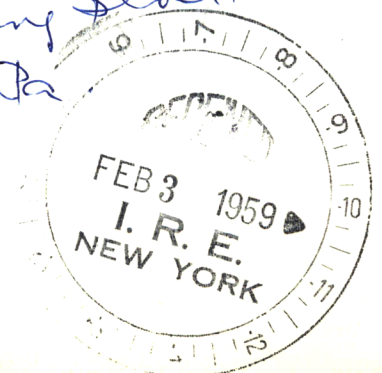
