(IEEE Bylaw 406.1).

A petition, signed by not less than twelve (12) Section members, above Student grade, who are members of the Society shall be submitted to the Section Executive Committee, via the Section Secretary, for approval. It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

The petition shall specify:

- The name of the Society
- The name and address of the Chapter organizer

Field Services Staff will review the petition and work with the organizer to resolve any discrepancies. The Chapter shall be considered established after Field Services has ascertained that the Regional Director and the Society President(s) have no objections to the formation of the Chapter.

Following approval, the Section Chairman, the Chapter Organizer, the Regional Director and the President of the Society will be notified. The Chapter formation will be noted in the Report of the Staff Director at the next meeting of the Regional Acitivites Board.

TO FORM A JOINT CHAPTER COVERING TWO OR MORE SOCIETIES

The requirements are the same as for a single Society Chapter, with the following exception. Of the 12 signatures on the petition, not less than three shall be members of each of the Societies involved.

For example, a joint Microwave Theory & Techniques (MTT-17) and Antennas & Propagation (AP-03) Society Chapters might be formed with eight petitioners belonging to MTT-17 and four petitioners to AP-03. It is not required, though it may be useful, that Chapter members or officers maintain membership in both Societies. It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

TO FORM A JOINT CHAPTER COVERING TWO OR MORE CONTIGUOUS SECTIONS

A petition must be signed by not less than twelve (12) members, other than Students, of the Sections involved, who are members of the Society or Societies, and submitted for approval by the pertinent Sections Executive Committees. It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

The petition shall specify:

- The names of the Sections involved
- The name(s) of the Society or Societies
- The name and address of the Chapter Organizer
- The organizational unit (administrative parent Section) which shall be responsible for the Chapter management. In joint Chapters, administrative matters relate to the parent Section.

With the written approval of the entities involved, the petition shall be mailed to:







Dear Prof. Novak:

I was pleased to learn from your letter of June 6, 1972 to Dr. J.H. Mulligan about possible contacts between the Czechoslovak Scientific-Technical Society and the IEEE. The IEEE is interested in exploring such contacts and would welcome the exchange of letters on this subject. From your association with Dr. S.K. Mitra, I infer that you are already a member of the IEEE so I assume that you are already somewhat familiar with our membership organization. At any rate, our organization is established to serve its members on scientific and educational matters through conferences, publications, and other methods of information.

We have been exploring ways of serving our members more effectively and for developing new memberships in other countries of the world. The IEEE has made a particular effort to develop ways of interacting with technical societies that are interested in electrical and electronic engineering in various countries of the world. One convenient way for this interaction to take place is for there to be a section of the IEEE in the country involved, i.e., for there to be 25 or more members in that country, who apply for IEEE section status, and for this section and the national technical society to have common programs or meetings. By copy of this letter to Prof. Paul Jespers, University of Louvain, Institut Electrotechnique, 95 Kard, Mercierlaan, 3030 Heverlee, Belgium, Director IEEE Region 8, I am suggesting that he contact you and describe for you some of the benefits to be derived from participating in IEEE Region activities.

Other ways for interaction between a society such as the Czechoslovak Scientific-Technical Society and the IEEE have also been developed that involve joint memberships with reduced joint fees for dual membership with some common services. It is of interest to note that the IEEE covers 6 major technical Divisions such as Theory, Information and Control, Power and Industry, Communications, Electronics, Computers, and Man-Machine Systems. The question of just what areas of common technical concern should be considered is something that should be explored. By copy of this letter, I am asking Mr. C.F. Stewart, IEEE Director Regional Activities, to send you more information about the IEEE.

Thank you for your expression of interest in the IEEE. Messrs. Jespers, Stewart and I plan to be in Brussels, Belgium in mid-November and perhaps we could get together with you and/or Prof. B.Kvasil at that time to consider the subject of possible contacts between our two organizations at that time.


