TRI-Cities Section

By-Laws

ARTICLE I - NAME

Sec. 1. This organization shall be known as the TRI-Cities Section of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, Inc..

Sec. 2. It is the object of this Section to further the aims and ideals of the Institute and to promote the welfare of its own members through the holding of meetings and field trips for the study of subjects of an engineering or scientific nature or of interest and value to Institute members.

Sec. 3. The territory served by this Section, as designated in the Institute By-Laws and as approved by the Regional Director and Regional Activities Board is composed of the Counties of:

Carter, Greene, Hancock, Hawkins, Johnson, Sullivan, Unicoi, and Washington Counties of the State of Tennessee; Lee, Scott, and Wise Counties of the State of Virginia; and Harlan County of the State of Kentucky

ARTICLE II - BY-LAWS

Sec. 1. These By-laws are established to govern the operation and administration of the Virginia Mountain Section.

Sec. 2. These By-laws and amendments thereto or revocation thereof shall be adopted by a two thirds majority of all votes cast at a regular meeting or by mail ballot, provided notice has been given to all members at least 20 days prior to such vote.

Sec. 3. A copy of current Section By-laws shall be submitted for approval to the Regional Director.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Sec. 1. Members of this Section shall be of two classes: Regular Members, and Student Members, as defined in the following paragraphs:

Sec. 2. Regular Members of this Section shall be defined as those IEEE Fellows, Senior Members, Members and Associates in good standing and having residence within the jurisdiction of this Section. Only Regular Members shall be entitled to vote or to hold office, except Associates shall not hold office.

Sec. 3. Student Members of this Section shall be defined as those IEEE enrolled students in good standing and residing within the jurisdiction of the Section. Student Members shall not be entitled to vote or to hold office.

PRELIMINARY

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP (CONTINUED)

Sec. 4. All IEEE Members with mailing addresses within the approved territory of the section are automatically members of the section unless individual members choose membership in a contiguous section in accordance with IEEE By-laws. Certain other members of IEEE residing in contiguous territory may become members of the section in accordance with IEEE By-laws.

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

Sec. 1. Officers of the Section shall be Chairman, Vice Chairman, a Secretary-Treasurer and four Members-at-Large of the Executive Committee, all of whom shall hold office for one year beginning on June 1, with the exception of Chairman, who at the expiration of the term for which he is elected shall, as Junior Past Chairman, be a member of the Executive Committee for the following year.

Sec. 2. The Section Chairman shall be the executive officer of the Section, assuming the duties and obligations usually pertaining to that office.

Sec. 3. The Section Vice Chairman shall be the Junior Officer and Program Chairman of the Section, assuming the duties and obligations usually pertaining to that office.

Sec. 4. The Secretary-Treasurer shall perform the duties and obligations usually pertaining to those offices and such other duties as may be assigned by the Executive Committee.

Sec. 5. The Section shall be governed by an Executive Committee consisting of the Section Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary-Treasurer, four Members-At-Large, Junior Past Chairman of the Section, and Chairmen of Subsections or Chapters. A quorum shall consist of ~~five or more members~~ *the majority of the Executive Committee* ^{etc}

Sec. 6. Any officers may be removed for cause by the Executive Committee at any Executive Committee meeting upon the vote of at least 75 percent of the total Executive Committee membership, provided a motion to that effect shall have been made at a similar meeting at least thirty days before and provided that a copy of such motion together with a statement of charges shall have been delivered forthwith to the officer in question. Such officer shall have the right of defense.

Sec. 7. Any vacancy occurring within the Executive Committee shall be filled by Executive Committee appointment. In making such appointment or appointments, the Executive Committee shall adhere to the specific plan of progression established by these By-laws; except that, in case of vacancy of the Junior Past Chairman, the appointee shall be the next available past Chairman in recency of service. Any person so appointed shall hold office until the next succeeding annual election.

ARTICLE V - NOMINATIONS

Sec. 1. The Nominating Committee shall be composed of the three most recent Past Chairmen who are able and willing to serve. The Junior Past Chairman shall assume the duty of forming the Nominating Committee and shall be its Chairman. This Nominating Committee shall meet not later than March 1, and shall announce the slate by mail to all voting members by March 10. The announcement shall state that additional nominations by petition will be accepted if delivered to the Secretary-Treasurer by April 10.

Sec. 2. The Nominating Committee shall nominate a regular ticket consisting of one candidate for Chairman, one candidate for Vice Chairman, one candidate for the office of Secretary-Treasurer and eight candidates for a total of four offices for members-at-large of the Executive Committee.

PRELIMINARY

ARTICLE V - NOMINATIONS (CONTINUED)

Sec. 3. The Nominating Committee shall guide its actions by the following specific provisions:

- (a) The nominee for the office of Chairman preferably shall be the Section Vice Chairman.
- (b) The nominee for the office of Vice Chairman preferably shall be the Section Secretary-Treasurer.
- (c) The nominee for the office of Secretary-Treasurer shall be chosen from among Section members.

Sec. 4. Nominations for any or all offices may be made by petition under the following provisions:

- (a) Such petition or petitions must bear personal signature of at least 10% or 25 regular members of this section, whichever is the smaller.
- (b) Such petition or petitions must be delivered to the Secretary-Treasurer not later than April 10.
- (c) The nominee or nominees covered by such petition or petitions shall be included in the regular ballot and designated as such.

ARTICLE VI - ELECTIONS

Sec. 1. Not later than April 25 of each year the Secretary-Treasurer shall prepare and mail to each regular member of this Section an official ballot together with a pre-addressed return envelope.

Sec. 2. The official ballot shall contain the names of all nominees duly proposed in accordance with these By-laws.

Sec. 3. The official ballot shall contain also one blank space for each office, which space may be used by voting members for the purpose of writing in an alternate name.

Sec. 4. Only official ballots shall be counted, and to be accepted shall be enclosed in the sealed mailing envelope which must bear the identifying signature of the voting member and must reach the Chairman-Tellers Committee not later than 12 o'clock noon, May 15.

Sec. 5. A committee of three or more tellers not running for office shall be appointed by the Section Chairman prior to April 10, of each year. The Chairman of the Teller's Committee shall receive the mailed ballots and accumulate them, unopened. Prior to tallying the votes, the Secretary-Treasurer and the Chairman of the Teller's Committee shall jointly verify the names on the outer envelope against the official, up-to-date list of the regular members of this Section, separating unopened, any and all ballots from ineligible persons. The results of the election shall be typed in triplicate, bearing the personal signature of all members of the Committee of Tellers, together with the date of the count. One such copy shall be delivered by May 25, to the Secretary-Treasurer and Chairman. The third such copy shall remain in the possession of the Chairman of the Committee of Tellers at least until after publication of the announcement of the election results. The copy delivered to the Secretary-Treasurer shall be retained in the permanent files of the Secretary-Treasurer.

In case of a tie in the votes for any office, it shall be resolved in favor of one of the candidates so tied by a majority of the votes cast by the members of the Executive Committee at a meeting to be called immediately after the count of votes by the tellers; a record of such vote shall be entered in the minutes of said meeting of the Executive Committee.

Sec. 6. At the Section meeting next succeeding the annual election the presiding officer shall read the report of the Committee of Tellers and shall declare duly elected the eligible candidate receiving the greatest number of votes for each office.

PRELIMINARY

ARTICLE VI - ELECTIONS (CONTINUED)

Sec. 1. Duly elected officers shall assume their official duties on the first day of June next succeeding their election and shall hold office for one year or until their successors take office.

ARTICLE VII - COMMITTEES

Sec. 1. Standing Committees of this Section shall include a Program Committee, Publicity Committee, and Membership and Transfer Committee and such other committees as may be required in the discretion of the Executive Committee. The chairman of all committees will be appointed by the Section Chairman except the Program Chairman who shall be the Vice Chairman.

Sec. 2. The personnel of any standing or special committee may be appointed by ~~the~~ chairman subject to the discretion of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VIII - MEETINGS

Sec. 1. Section meetings shall be held as scheduled by the Executive Committee.

Sec. 2. Regular members of this section shall be notified of the time and place of each Section meeting and of the subject to be presented at the meeting. The Student Branches within the territory served by this Section shall be notified of the subject, time and place of Section meetings.

Sec. 3. Special meetings may be called at any time by the Executive Committee upon written notice thereof being sent out in advance of the meeting.

ARTICLE IX - DUES

Sec. 1. Regular and student members shall pay no Section dues.

ARTICLE X - GENERAL

Sec. 1. Business may be transacted at those Section meetings where 10% or 25 of the Regular members, whichever is the greater, are present. *90* Business requiring the vote of these members in attendance is contingent upon the number who have been given notice of business to be conducted via a newsletter or other acceptable means of notification.

Sec. 3. In order to provide for proper handling of the Section's routine work and the management of its affairs, the Executive Committee may adopt, in connection with these By-laws, such rules and regulations as may be found necessary, but no rule or regulation shall be adopted which will conflict with the Constitution and By-laws of this Section or with the Constitution and By-laws of the Institute.

AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

ARTICLE XI

Sec. 1. Proposals for amendments may originate in the Executive Committee or by petition.

Sec. 2. Petitions for amendments must bear the personal signature of at least twenty percent of Regular Members of this Section together with the date of each signature.

PRELIMINARY

ARTICLE XI (CONTINUED)

Sec. 3. Amendments proposed by petition shall be submitted for vote within sixty days of the receipt of the petition or petitions by the Secretary-Treasurer.

Sec. 4. Proposed amendments in full shall be submitted, in a form to clearly indicate the change being proposed, to each Regular Member of the Section for ballot. The votes cast shall be counted by the Executive Committee at its next meeting following the closing date of the balloting. A proposed amendment shall be declared adopted and become effective if a majority of the votes cast are affirmative and when a true copy thereof, together with a record of the count of votes, shall have been certified to the Secretary-Treasurer for inclusion into the minutes of the said meeting.

Sec. 5. The By-laws so amended shall be submitted to the Regional Director for formal approval.

Sec. 6. The Executive Committee may, at its discretion, refuse to resubmit a defeated proposal within the current fiscal year.

SUBSECTIONS

ARTICLE XII

Sec. 1. Subsections shall be subject to the by-laws of the Section and shall be under the general jurisdiction of the Section Executive Committee.

Sec. 2. The territory and limits of the subsections shall be subject to definition and change by the Section Executive Committee and approval by the Regional Director and the Regional Activities Board.

Sec. 3. The subsection shall have three officers, a subsection Chairman, a subsection Vice Chairman and a subsection Secretary-Treasurer.

Sec. 4. Any vacancy occurring in the offices of the subsection shall be filled by appointment; such appointment to be made at the discretion of the subsection.

Sec. 5. All committee chairmen shall be appointed by the subsection Chairman.

Sec. 6. The personnel of any standing or special committee shall be appointed by the Chairman of the subsection.

Sec. 7. Finances of the subsection shall be operated on an annual budget approved by the Section Executive Committee. Expenditures from Section funds shall not exceed the annual budget without prior approval of the Section Executive Committee.

Sec. 8. Nominations and election of the three Subsection officers will be as described for the Section in Articles V and VI except that Sub-section officers will function in the place of Section officers.

Sec. 9. Regular meetings shall generally be held at such times and places as may be designated by the subsection Chairman.

ARTICLE XIII - CHAPTERS

Sec. 1. A chapter of a Society or Group may be promoted by the Section, or by a Society or Group, or by their respective members, by submitting a petition signed by twelve (12) or more members of the Section who are members of the Society or Group. The chapter shall be deemed established after approval of the petition by the Executive Committee of the Section, the President of that Society or Group, and the Regional Director.

ARTICLE XIII - CHAPTERS

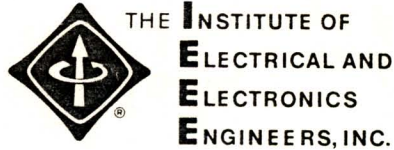
Sec. 2. The responsibility for Chapter management shall rest with the Section, which shall have control of all financial and other assets of the chapter in carrying out its activities. In effect, the chapter will function in a manner similar to that of a committee of the Section.

Sec. 3. Membership of the chapter will consist of all members of the Section who are members of the particular Group or Society.

Sec. 4. A chapter may elect its own Chairman and other desired officers. Those elected shall hold the grade of Fellow, Senior Member or Member.

Sec. 5. All technical meetings of the chapter shall announced to and be open to all members of the Section and to affiliates of the Chapter within the Section.

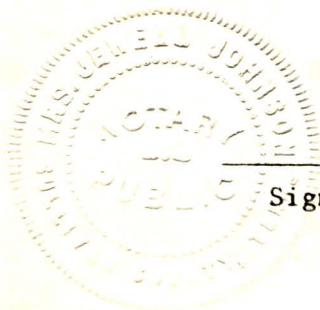

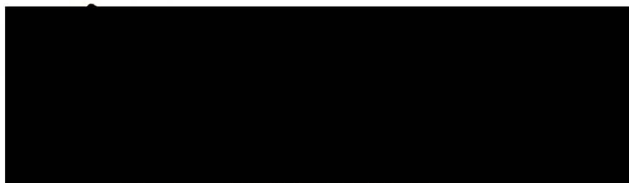

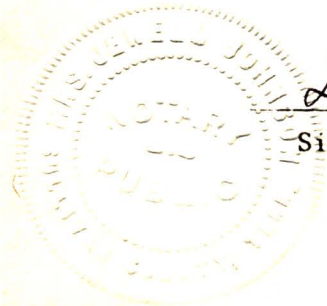

COMPUTER CHAPTER BY-LAWS

Article I - Name

Section 1. This organization shall be known as the IEEE TRI-CITIES Chapter on _____
(Section)
Computer Society
(Group/Society)

Section 2. Hereafter "Chapter" shall refer to the organization named in Section 1. "Group" or "Society" shall refer to the Group/Society named in Section 1, and "Section" shall refer to _____
TRI-cities [a] Section of The Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers.

Article II - Field of Interest and Objectives

Section 1. The field of interest of the Chapter shall be that defined in the Constitution of the ~~Computer~~ Society.

Section 2. The Chapter shall sponsor meetings of the Section within the field of interest of the Chapter, shall provide the necessary personnel for Section committees, and shall assist in any Group/Society symposium or conference held within the Section territory. The Chapter shall be responsible for coordination with the Section on such symposia or conferences.

Article III - Membership

Section 1. The members of the Chapter shall be all IEEE Section members of any grade who are also members of the ~~Computer~~ Society.

Section 2. Affiliates of the Group/Society in good standing with mailing address within the territory of the Section shall be Affiliates of the Chapter.

Article IV - Officers and Management

Section 1. A Chapter may elect its own chairman and other desired officers who shall be members of the ~~Computer~~ Society. Those elected shall hold the grade of Fellow, Senior Member or Member.

Section 2. The Chapter shall be managed by an Administrative Committee composed of the officers of the Chapter, the chairmen of all standing committees of the Chapter, and the Vice-Chairman of the Section, or his representative, ex officio. The Administrative Committee may elect by a majority vote additional members from the Chapter. The Administrative Committee shall be responsible for carrying out locally the program of the Group/Society and shall be governed by the

actions of the Administrative Committee of the Group/Society. It shall be responsible for making such reports to the Groups and Societies as may be required by their Bylaws, and for making meeting and financial reports to the Section.

Section 3. An Affiliate is eligible to serve only in appointive offices in the Chapter of the Group or Society with which he is affiliated, or as may be authorized by the IEEE Executive Committee.

Section 4. The term of office of all Chapter officers shall be one year coincident with the term of Section officers. The Administrative Committee shall fill vacancies of office occurring during the year.

Section 5. At least 180 DAYS [b] prior to the Annual Meeting of the Chapter, the Chairman shall appoint a Nominating Committee which shall submit a list of candidates to the Administrative Committee at least 120 DAYS [c] prior to said Annual Meeting.

Article V - Duties of the Officers

Section 1. The Chapter Chairman shall have general supervision of the Chapter in all its activities, shall preside at all meetings of the Chapter per se and of its Administrative Committee, and shall represent the Chapter at all meetings, Sectional, Regional or otherwise, having business or activity embraced by the field of interest of the Group/Society.

Section 2. The Vice-Chairman shall assume the duties of the Chairman during the latter's absence or incapacity, and shall assume any of the duties of the office of the chairman when so directed by the Chairman.

Section 3. The Secretary shall keep accurate minutes and records for all activities of the Chapter and its Administrative Committee, and shall make such reports as are required by the Section or the Group/Society pertaining to all activities and the financial status of the Chapter.

Section 4. As soon as feasible after election, the Chairman shall appoint the chairmen of the following standing committees:

- Membership
- Meetings and Papers
- Publicity and Arrangements

Section 5. Annually elected officers and other members of the Administrative Committee shall assume office concurrently with the newly elected officers of the Section.

- (5) Many Chapters have a standard procedure for a "Membership Desk" at all Chapter meetings, with an ample supply of IEEE and Group/Society membership blanks available and a committee member on hand to answer questions.
 - (6) In most Sections it would be desirable for the Section and Chapter Membership Committees to coordinate their membership recruitment activities.
 - (7) Membership does not stop with trying to get new Chapter members. It means maintaining membership relationships with good programs, good meeting notices, follow through with telephone calls to members who have not been attending meetings.
 - (8) The Chapter, in coordination with the Section, should seek active support of commercial, professional, industrial and governmental bodies through the use of their bulletin boards and publications, to advertise IEEE benefits in participation and publication.
 - (9) The Committee should be constantly aware of the desirability of motivating members to upgrade their membership whenever they so qualify. The continued strength of the Institute, and thus of the Chapter, is in its growth, which is no better recognized than in the move to Senior Member and subsequently to Fellow grade.
- d. Awards Committee. Members of the Chapter Awards Committee should acquaint themselves with all IEEE, Region, Section, Group, Society and Student Awards, including nominations for IEEE Fellow grade, and take appropriate actions to actively participate by submitting names of suitable candidates. The rules for IEEE Awards and Fellow nominations are available upon request to IEEE Headquarters.
- e. Nominating Committee. The functions of this Committee are (1) to select from the Chapter membership the names of candidates qualified for the elective offices of the Chapter and (2) to submit the names of candidates to be considered for the elective offices of the IEEE and for appointment to the Standing Committees and Boards of the IEEE.

Many Chapters have found it beneficial to preserve continuity by rotating the offices, with the Secretary elevated to Vice-Chairman, the Vice-Chairman elevated to Chairman, etc.

The Nominating Committee shall determine that each of the nominees is eligible and willing to accept nomination and the office, if elected.

The ballot to the voting Chapter members (all members above Student grade) should allow space for write-ins. The services of IEEE Headquarters are available in preparing and mailing Chapter election ballots.

- f. Student Activities Committee. This Committee, working with its counterpart in the Section, is responsible for Chapter cooperation with the various Student Branches and support of Student activities within the Section territory. The Committee should encourage Students who are enrolled in the Group or Society to attend the Chapter meetings and participate in Group activities.

C. SECTION ORGANIZATION

- 1. Roster. To operate effectively and coordinate activities of the Chapter and Section, it is important that the Chapter Chairman learn the names of Section officers and those appointed to Section Committees with their names, addresses and telephone numbers furnished to all members of the Chapter Administrative Committee.
- 2. Section Bylaws. Sections are required to adopt local Bylaws which are in consonance with the IEEE Bylaws. The Chapter Chairman shall obtain from the Section Chairman copies for distribution to all members of the Chapter Administrative Committee.
- 3. Section Meeting Calendar. The Section, Subsection and Chapter meetings calendar, when established, should be distributed to all Chapter officers.

PRELIMINARY

Section 2. The members of the Chapter shall elect annually the Chapter officers from the Chapter membership. Election shall be by direct vote of the members at the Annual Meeting, unless the election is held by mail ballot at least two weeks prior to said meeting. Provision for mail vote shall be made in a mail ballot. A plurality of votes cast shall elect. The Administrative Committee or its designees shall constitute a Tellers Committee.

Section 3. An Affiliate cannot serve in an elective office in a Chapter nor vote for candidates for these offices unless authorized by the IEEE Executive Committee.

Article X - Amendments

Section 1. Amendments to these Bylaws may be initiated by a majority of the Chapter Administrative Committee or by petition bearing fifteen signatures of Chapter members. A two-thirds vote of the Chapter Administrative Committee shall be required to approve proposed amendments for submittal to the Section Executive Committee for final approval.

All changes in the Bylaws must be consonant with the Constitution and Bylaws of the IEEE, the Group, the Society, and the Section.
